





5 Shelter Response Plan

- Government has requested IOM to support the development of a "shelter response plan" for the short and medium term.
- CADENA shared request from Government for Shelter for 250,000 persons
- Cabinet share first plans for support



5 Shelter Response Plan

- Many people avoid staying in Emergency Shelters and stay in there community
- Government has requested IOM to support the development of a "shelter response plan" for the short and medium term.
- The is no "one size fits all" solution -> Emergency repairs, rental support, informal settlement support, emergency shelter expansion / upgrade, temporary evacuation of vulnerable,
