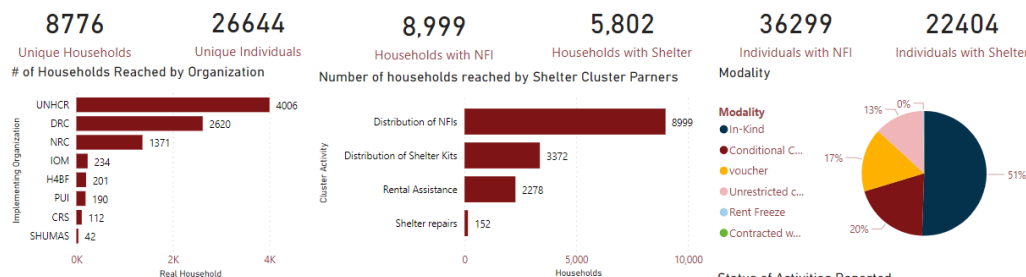
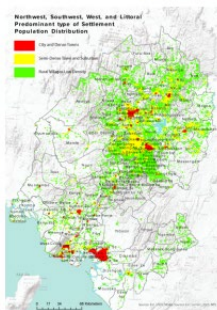
Displacement and Migratory movements of Displaced

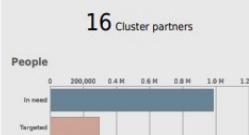


HIGHLIGHTS

3916 individuals were reached with Shelter and NFI assistance in the month of May. This drop in beneficiaries can be explained due to the need of partners to prepare the next phase of their implementation by conducting assessments to confirm shelter needs. From the 18th-20th of May, a holiday was observed by many humanitarian agencies due to the Cameroon Republic Day. These days were also observed as lockdown days which limited humanitarian actors in the implementation of their activities.

The Shelter Cluster launched its strategy review which will include updates to consider the situation of displacement in the West and Littoral Regions.

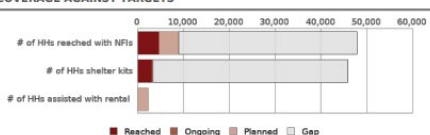

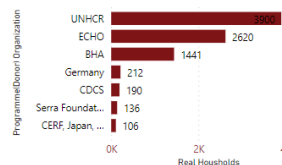
COVERAGE AGAINST TARGETS



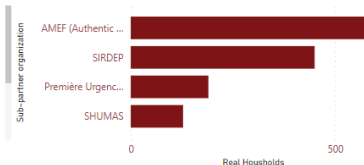

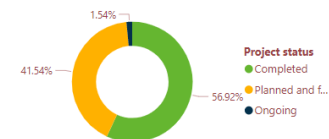


Real Households by Sub-partner organization

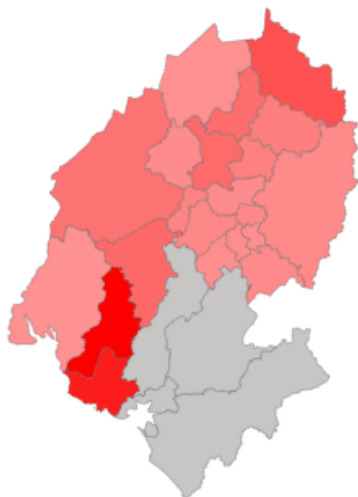
