#### **General Overview**

- There are still **400 container** sites accommodating **over 670,000 individuals**.
- 1.5 million individuals are receiving rent support.
- 220,000 containers were distributed (146,000 in sites)
- Construction of 207,000 houses is still ongoing; local authorities envision 150,000 houses before the end of the year 2024 and 400,000 houses in total before the end of next year.





## Activities by the sector - Community Engagement/Referrals/Site Improvement/NFI Distribution

- TSS sector partners conducted mobile TSS activities in 3,606 informal sites and/or neighborhoods including awareness raising, information dissemination and profiling of needs and refer to other sectors benefiting estimated 25790 households and 101467 individuals.
- TSS sector partners completed 3,603 referrals that included both individual and group level referrals to different sectors during this reporting period-including WASH, Protection, Health, Shelter/NFI, cash, education etc.
- TSS sector partners as part of the winterization support distributed 33,151 communal NFIs such as fire extinguishers/ safety kits, lights, tool kits, snow kits, heaters, ACs, foldable ramps, information boards etc, benefiting an estimated 160,439 families and 659,620 individuals residing in temporary settlements.
- TSS sector partners installed and equipped 4 multipurpose communal spaces in Kahramanmaras (Necip Fazıl Container Site), Adiyaman (K40 and K25 in Gölbaşı district) and Hatay (Uzumdali), also gravelled and covered one site with keystones 17.000 m2.
- TSS sector partners as part of the site improvement activities proceed with the graveling of two container sites: I) Hatay Kırıkhan (Bahçelievler).







### Neighborhood Profiling

Neighborhood profiling activity was conducted during the period of 16 Nov-8 Dec 2023. The aim of the activity is to identify the patterns of the needs at the neighborhood level since the temporary settlements follow Area Based Approach. As TSS sector partners IOM, GHV, ACTED, StL and MSYD conducted the intersectoral data collection activity at the neighborhood level through key informants and based on the observation.

#### **Temporary settlement types by province**



















## Neighborhood Profiling - Intention of the Residents in temporary settlements








#### Winterization Coordination


- Lack of coordination with Shelter sector in general, which may result in overlapping and duplication, and inefficiency in the response.
- Before distributing heaters, it is important to ensure that the electrical infrastructure of the settlements and the containers is adequate. Thus, coordination with the site management and/or local authorities is mandatory.
- Ensure timely reporting to the existing needs and providing information about the covered needs is very important for coordination..

# **Key updates I 9 January 2024**

58 Container cities – 24,709 Container - 69,142 Indiv.

Rural: 44,412 containers - 11,919 Foldable containers

Total Individuals in containers: 116,554 – 20,682 HH

#### **General Updates:**

- AFAD covered foldable containers in rural areas with Tarps Shelter Sector conducted a field visit to 3 locations in Golbasi (from referrals) and found out that tarps needs are covered.
- Neighborhood-based intervention is planned. Agencies and organizations willing to work in disadvantaged neighborhoods can contact PDMM for cooperation.
- A new site (42 Containers) will be dedicated to people with disabilities. Currently, few families are residing there, authorities are welcoming agencies to work on improving access in the site for more information contact the ABC hub coordinator.
- 1500 tarps are needed at Adiyaman City Center formal sites.

- Applications for light repairs for moderate damage structures ended on 5 January. Applicants will submit their documents till April. Repairs will start as of April 2024.
- Informal tented sites based at Narlica will be transferred to Hilalkent in two weeks.
- 2 fire incidents took place in Hatay (Antakya and Samandag last week.

#### **Needs:**

- 7,000 (8x4m) Tarpaulins for AFAD containers protection from rain.
- Oil Heater (increased)
- Fire extinguishers: urgently needed by local authorities
- Plastic pallets for 140 RHU tents in Samandag.
- School + Library needed (CARE will engage with the need).

# **Key updates I 9 January 2024**

74 Container cities (52 in city center – 22 in rural areas) – 28,834 containers – 32,203 HH - 116,822 indiv.

Around 7,000 (3878 of which are foldable) containers in rural areas – 26,788 individuals

- A fire occurred in Beydağı BGM on 01.01.2024
- AFAD will provide SGI sheet roofing to all containers based at Ronesans 3 site.
- Malet-2 site: Management is providing electrical distribution panels with circuit breakers
- AFAD: Capacity of the electrical panels in the containers cities is sufficient for heaters.
- Fire safety messaging will be disseminated via SMS by local authorities.
- Tarpaulins implementation in rural areas to be delivered to the district governorship to which the area is affiliated.
- AFAD provided 1700 tarps in rural areas and a total of 1000 tarps applied on containers
- Affected people living in rural areas are moving to rented houses dues to weather conditions.

- 352 Foldable containers. All covered with tarps.

- NFIs are needed at far villages such as Keferdiz, Sakcagozu at Islahiye city.
- Drainage work + grounding is needed at the site.
- Shelter Sector Coordination Team visited Islahiye 3 Container Site on 17 January 2024.
- 339 foldable containers. All covered with tarps.
- WASH facilities are needed. The available WASH facilities were reported as out of use (due to congestion).
- Intersectoral communication is underway.



# Why SAG?

Shelter and NFI Coordination structures and systems exist at the Gaziantep and Hub levels to promote a consistent but decentralised level of coordination and allow for a timely and effective provision of assistance, including preparedness and immediate responses. However, as indicated above, the local authority in many places has not recognized such coordination bodies in terms of decision-making processes, resting much of the impact on the coordination platform.
