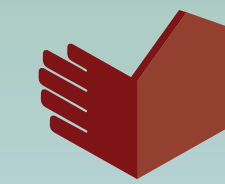

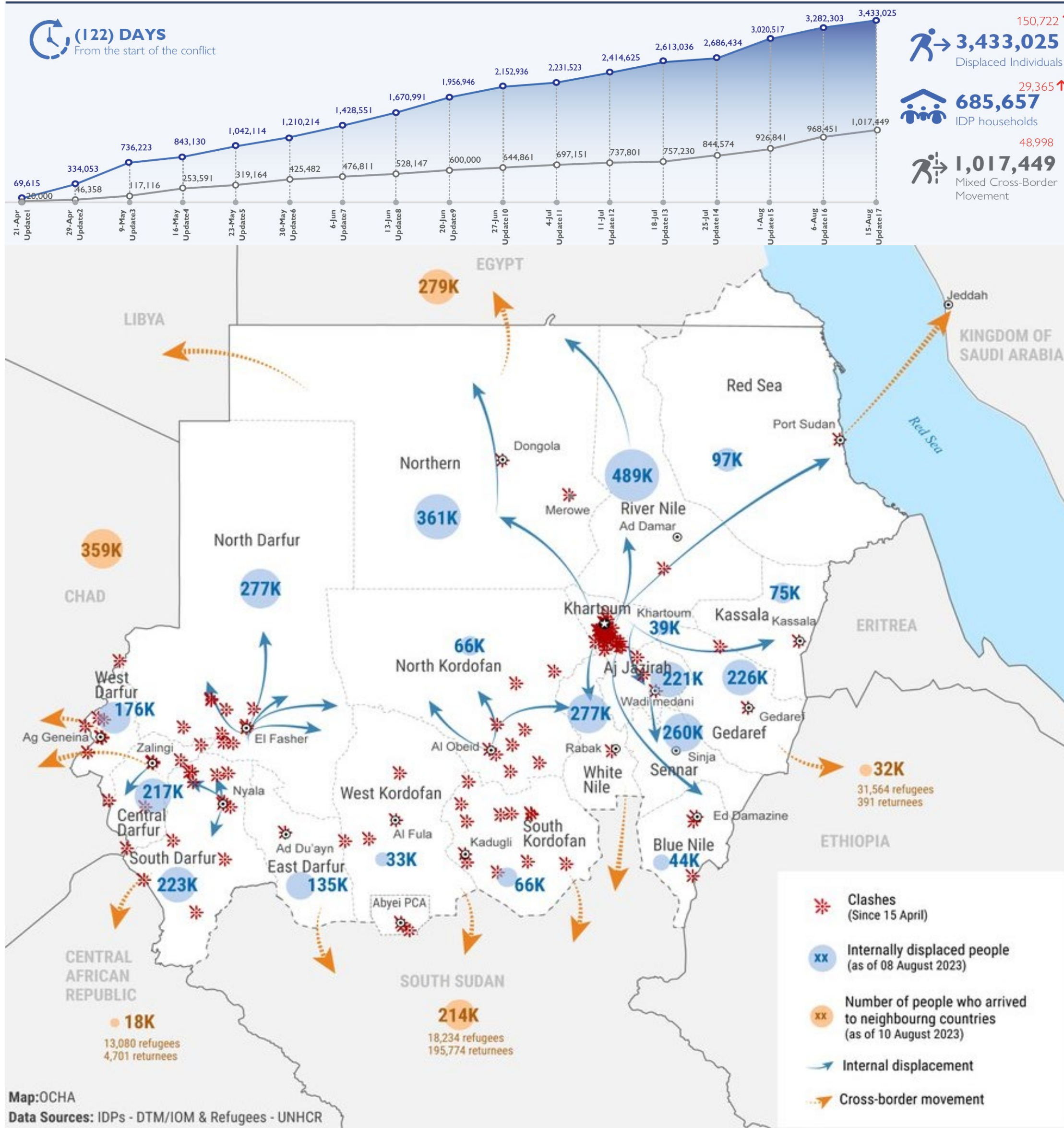

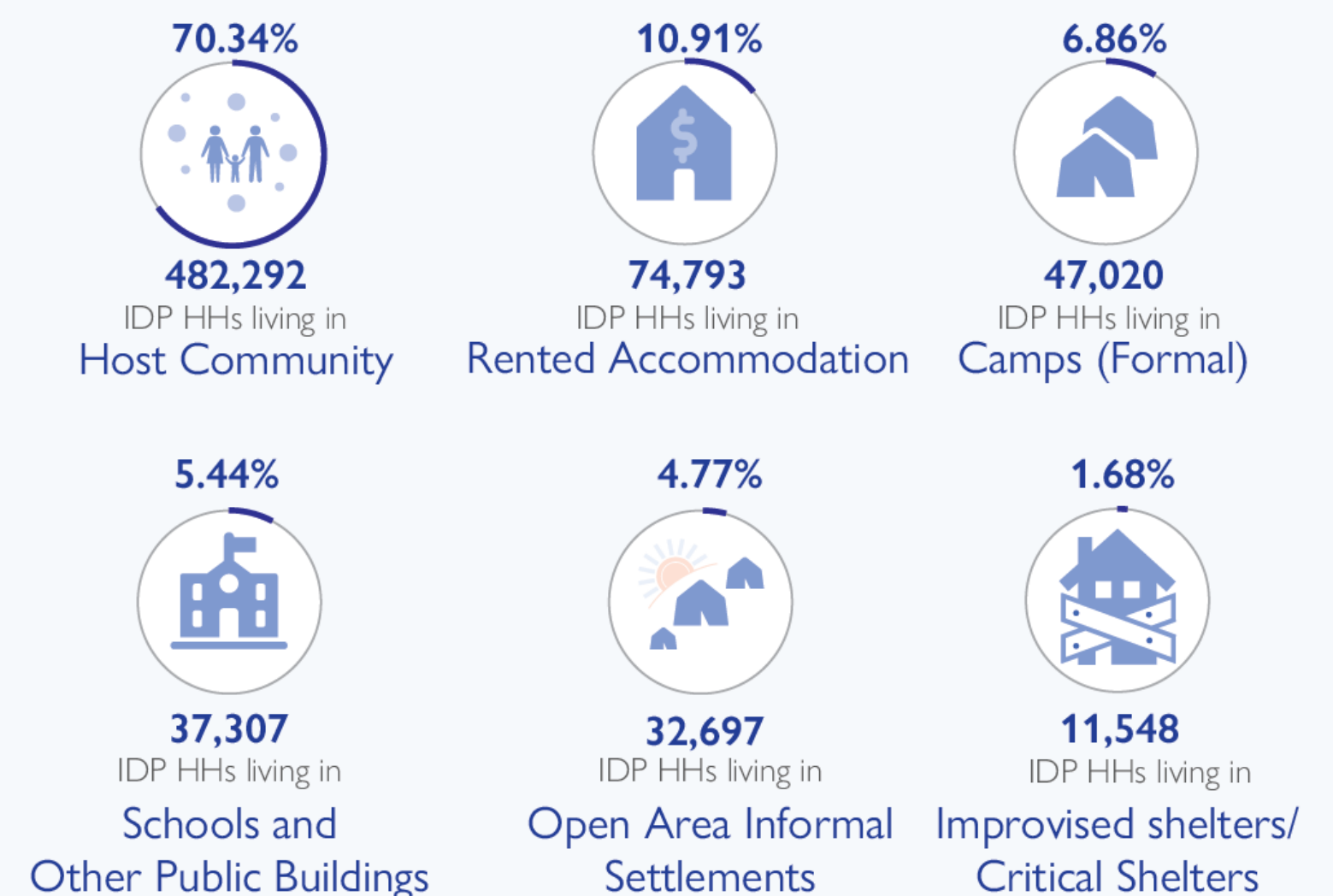

- Four months into the SAF-RSF conflict, over **4.4 million people** have been forced to flee their homes, continuing the same upward trend.
- Out of those, the estimated number of IDPs across Sudan is **3.4 million**. The current assessment has observed the IDP caseload in all of Sudan's 18 states. The highest proportions of IDPs have been observed in **River Nile** (14.59%), **Northern** (10.55%), **Sennar** (8.22%), **White Nile** (8.15%), and **North Darfur** (8.01%) states.
- At the same time, over **1 million** people have crossed into **neighbouring countries**.

Shelter categories



- Some 13,500 people have been affected by **heavy rains and flooding** in North Darfur, Northern, White Nile and Khartoum states, that we are aware of.
- In **North Darfur**, flooding caused by heavy rains has severely impacted IDPs in gathering sites in **Abu Shouk** and **Al Salam** IDP camps.
- Changing weather patterns saw Sudan's **Northern State** battered by heavy rain, damaging at least **464 houses**, with at least 300 houses damaged in **Merowe** city alone.
- **White Nile** continues to be one of the worst affected states by flooding. Flash floods swept away & destroyed everything in its path, families lost homes, property & many now sleep out in the cold. Accessibility to refugee camps is once again, constrained, including the new **Abu Doloa** site.
- In Khartoum, the rains have affected the area called **Al-Sagai**, about 40km north of Omdurman. The area was inundated with water and dozens of houses collapsed and agricultural plantings were submerged in the wake of the rains.

Strategy for Bridging Data Gaps

- Updated baseline population datasets (affected population, projected IDPs, refugees, vulnerable residents);
 - Levering on JIAF 2.0 approach;
 - Using proxy indicators / secondary data sources for clusters with data gaps;
 - Enhancing the 2023 needs analysis through an updated baseline population dataset;
 - Conducting rapid community-level needs assessments using mixed modalities that prioritize crucial indicators for each cluster and augment with household-level data where possible;
 - Adapting rapid needs assessment tools for further ad-hoc interoperable data collection.

Comprehensive Needs Assessment Tool: Designed to capture the full spectrum of shelter, NFI and settlement requirements: <https://enketo.unhcr.org/x/SvUGVngB>

Modular Approach: Offers flexibility to adapt to varied contexts.

Assessment Details: Core data collection for every scenario.

Household Composition and Vulnerabilities: Understanding specific needs.

Settlement Typology and HLP Issues: Gauging settlement challenges.

Shelter and Housing Needs: Identifying immediate and long-term shelter requirements.

NFI Needs: Pinpointing essential non-food items for support.

Access to Energy: Evaluating energy needs and sources.

Preferred Assistance: Gleaning beneficiary preferences for assistance type.

Settlement Situation and Access to Essential Services: Mapping out the services landscape.

Displacement Patterns: Understanding movement and motivations.

Versatility in Versions:

Household-Level Tool: For direct beneficiary assessment.

Community-Level Tool: Adapted for key informant interviews, focus group discussions, etc.

Objective: Ensure that our collective response efforts are well communicated to partners, donors, media and general audiences!

- **Achievements** – type of interventions, HH reached, locations, timeframe, etc.
 - **Challenges** – looting of supplies, access challenges, etc.
 - **Procurement** – quantities of stocks arriving to the country, type of stocks, timeframe, where will the stocks be prepositioned – particularly given the incoming flood season.
 - **Assessments** – e.g., needs assessments outlining specifics with respect to Shelter and NFI needs as well as market assessments on NFIs, shelter materials, or Cash for Rent.
 - **Context and impact** of interventions – e.g., any successes with respect to cash for rent, how is sustainability achieved, what about tenure security?
 - **Interventions in the host community** – with 77% of the population staying in host community – what has been achieved so far? Cash for shelter for the families hosting IDPs can be an option, or preselecting landlords to improve their housing in order for them to subsidize rent for IDPs – this can include negotiating longer-term tenure security.

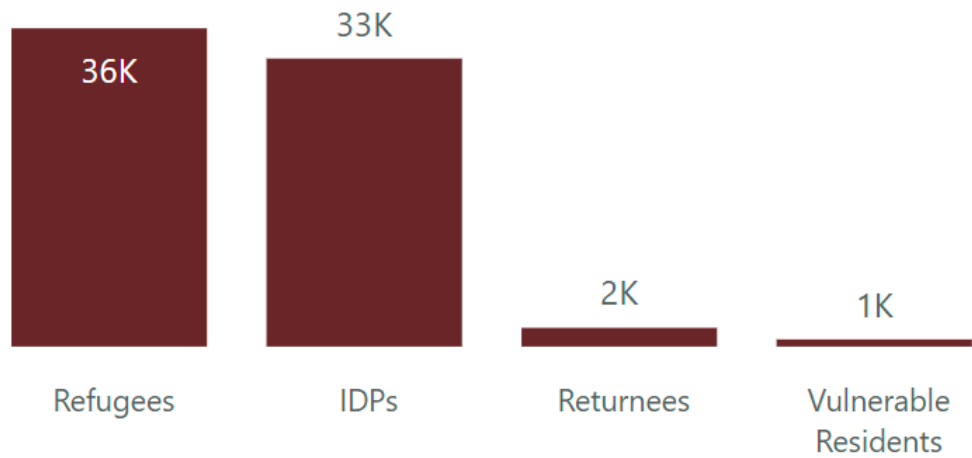
Household Reached by Response Type

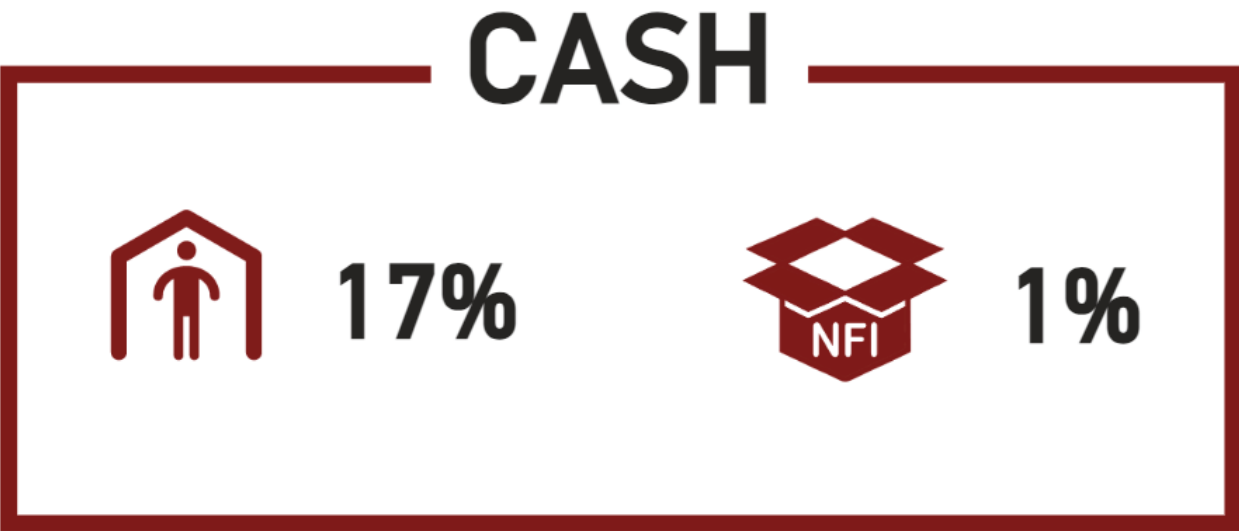
Overall Households Reached

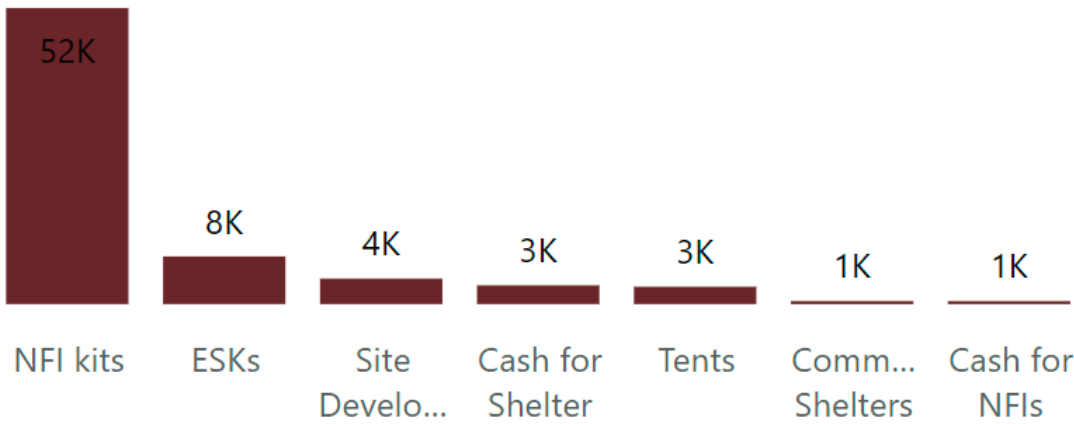

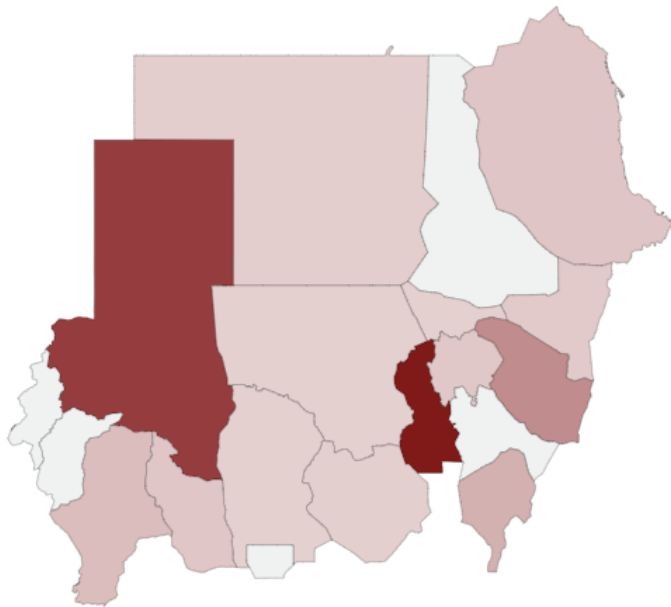

Household Reached by State

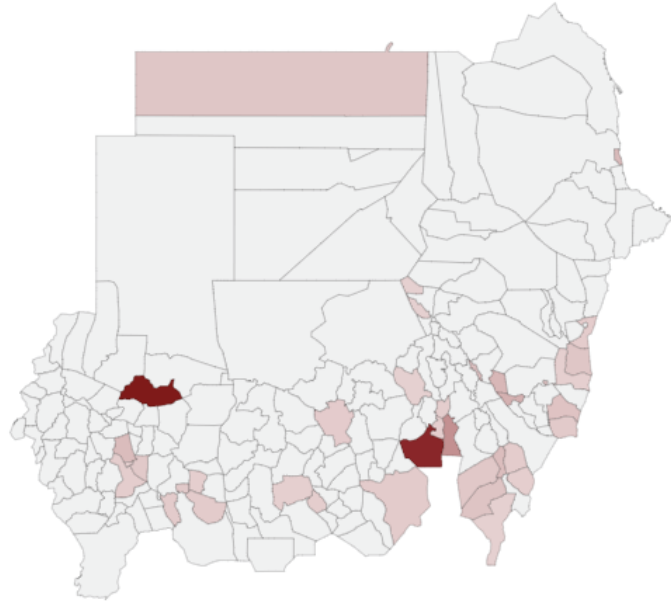

Shelter Cluster Meeting



21 August 2023

Update from Gedaref

- 309 HHs received plastic sheets for shelter improvement
- Rainy Season Preparedness:
 - 885 M roadside and secondary drainage were desilted
 - 4,600 M drainage were excavated



Other States Updates:

- In WNS, 443 NFI kits were distributed, 6,472 HHs received plastic sheets for shelter improvement
- In RS, 516 NFI kits were distributed
- In Northern State, 442 NFI kits were distributed to new the IDPs
- In Al Gazirah, 44 NFI kits were distributed
- In SK, 43 NFI kits were distributed



Cross Border Delivery – Darfur Response

- ❑ The construction of four rub halls are completed
- ❑ The 10,000 NFI kits arrived Farchana, all are stored in UNHCR warehouse
- ❑ Distribution plans are under discussion and agreement with the implementing partner

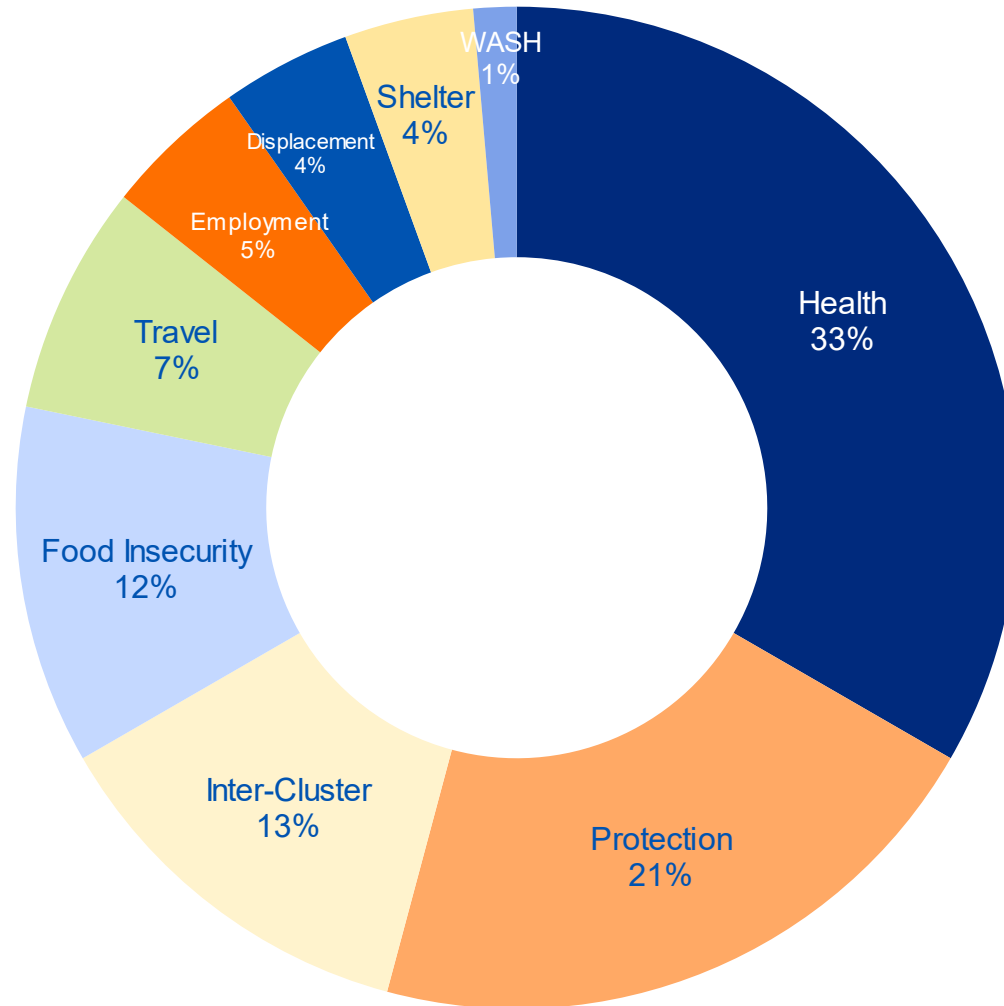

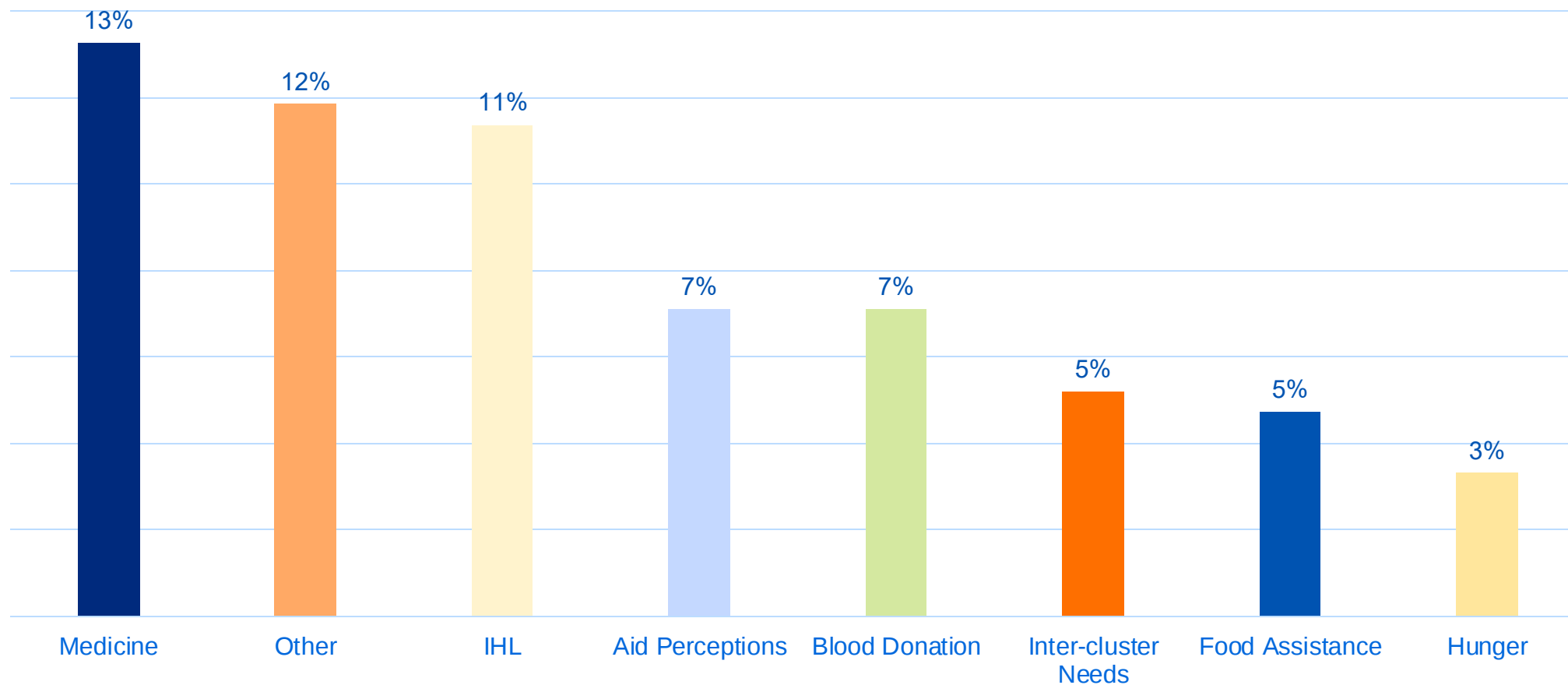

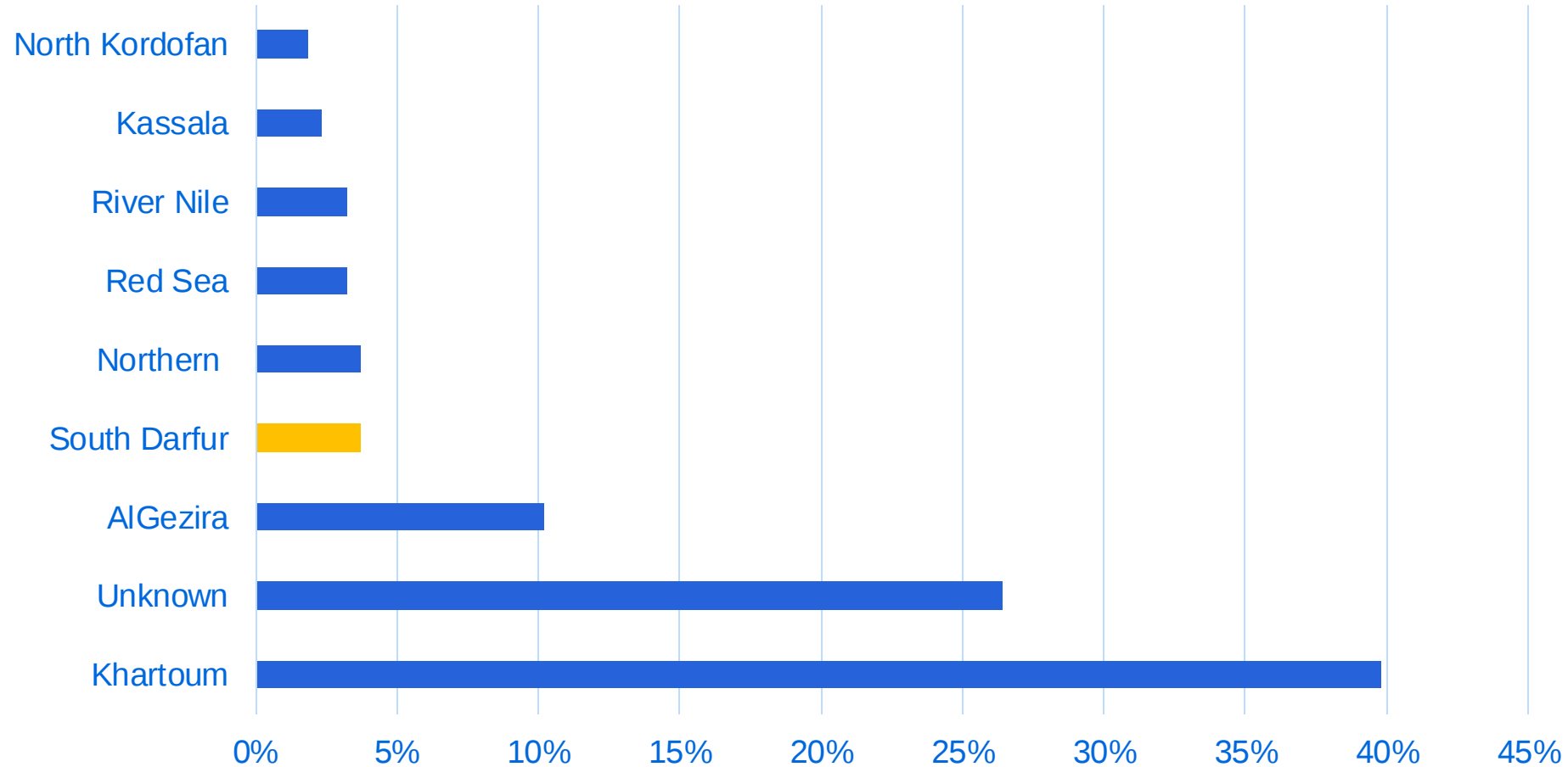
Social Media Data by Theme

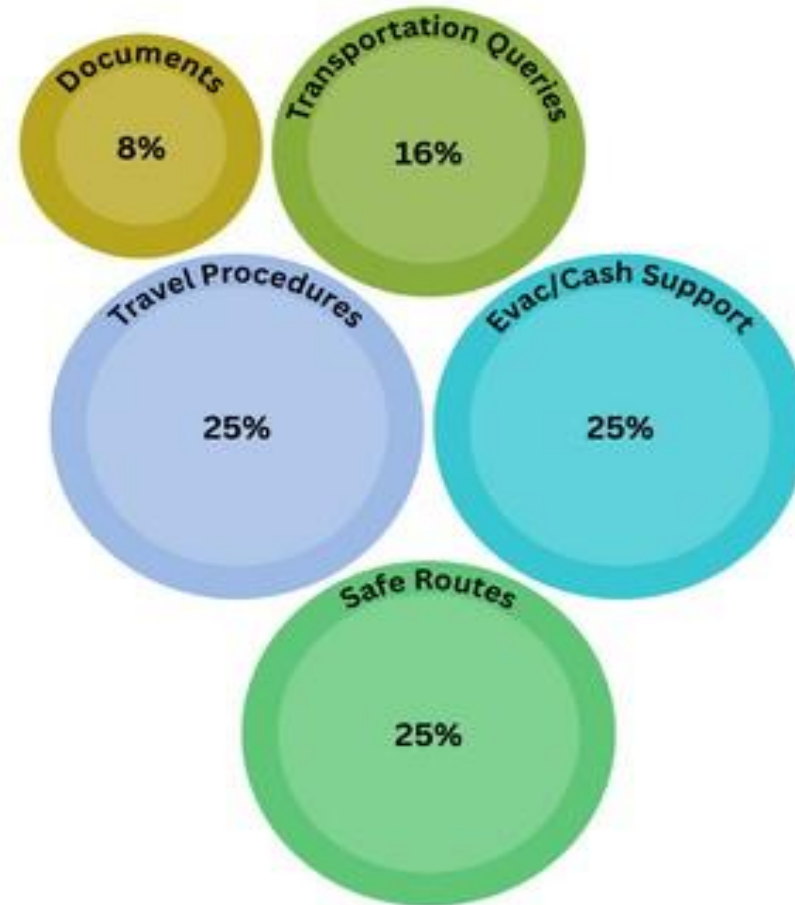

Urgent Needs in AlGeneina

"Geneina Resistance Committees Coordination press reports 60 days after the city of AlGeneina was invaded and its residents forcibly displaced...still killing and looting, even the doors, windows and ceilings have been removed or broken...**Weakness in the communication network and complete interruption of internet services.**

- ◆ The city's **IDP camps were demolished and destroyed parts of the Abu Zar camp, the complete demolition and destruction of the Gilani camp (AlGhabat), Krindag camp and the Hajjaj city camp...**Scarcity of medicines and medical services and high cases of malaria and infections.
- ◆ High prices of consumer goods and food supplies... most of the remaining population concentrated in the city of Ardamtā, to which they fled after the city of AlGeneina was destroyed. It is worth noting that there are still bodies on the roofs of the houses and inside the houses that have not been buried or dealt with...
- ◆ weak intervention of international and regional organizations"

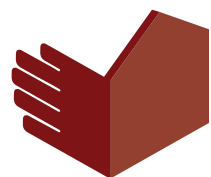
