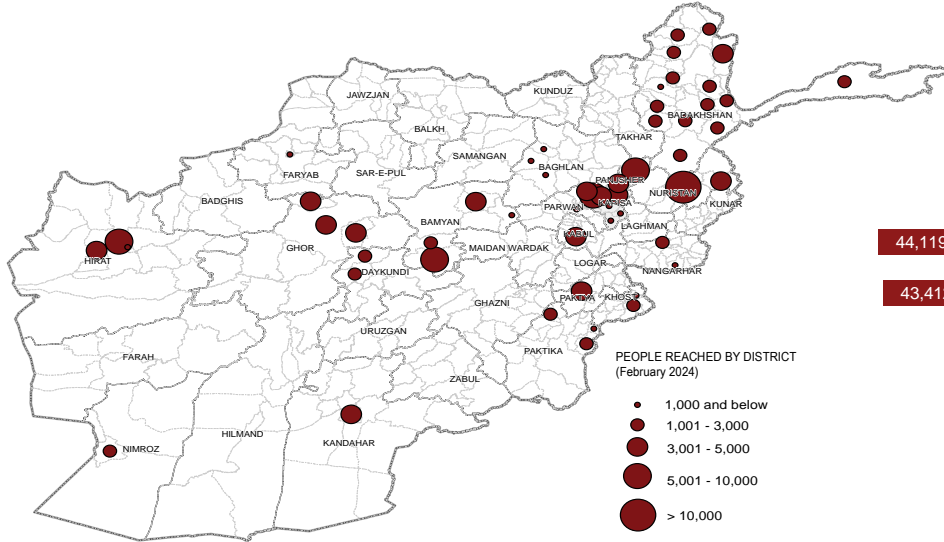


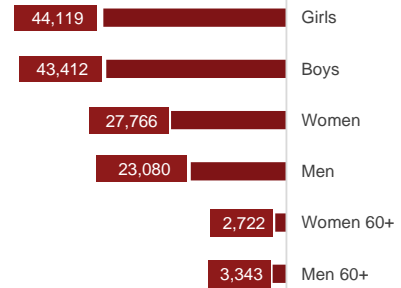

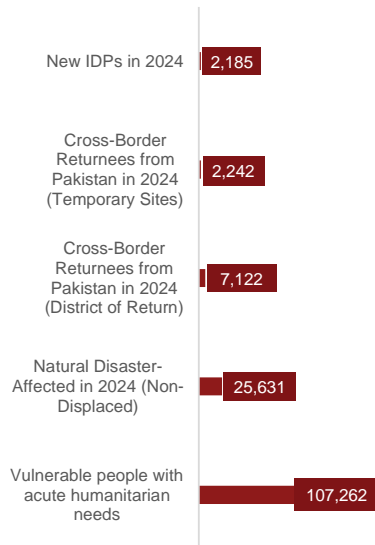
AGE & GENDER BREAKDOWN

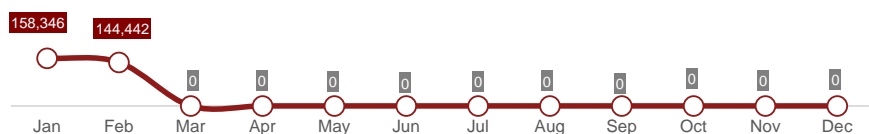
