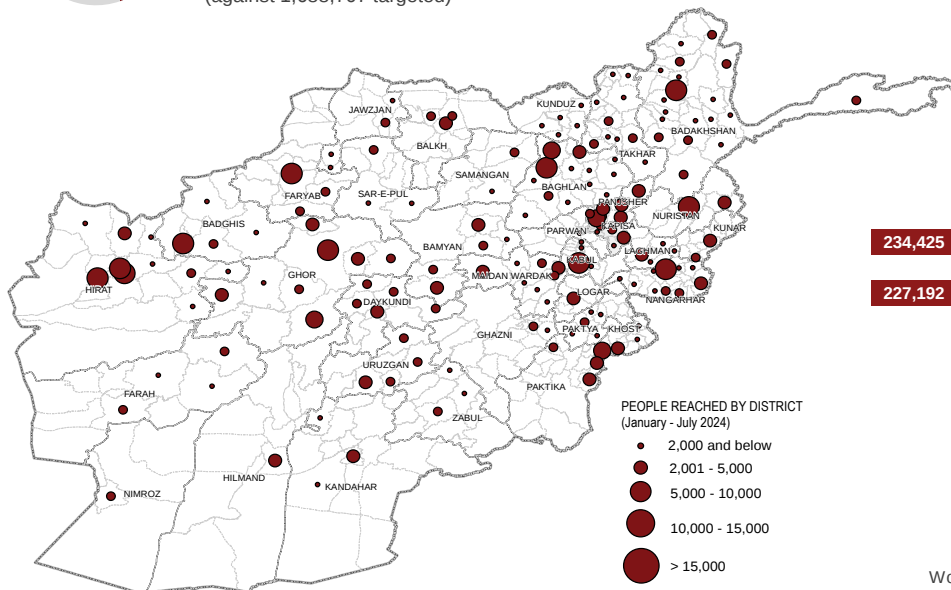


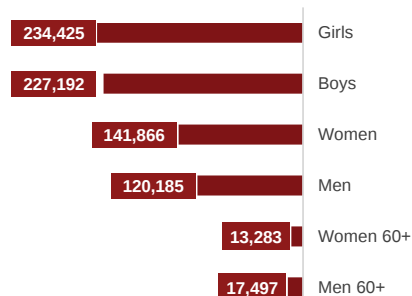

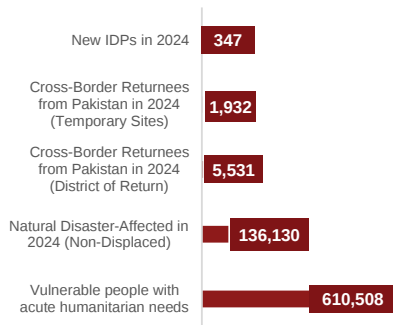
AGE & GENDER BREAKDOWN

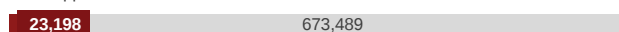


ES-NFI KEY INDICATORS

of people receiving standard winterization package including through heaters and fuel, winter clothing, blankets or quilts.



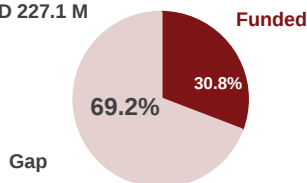

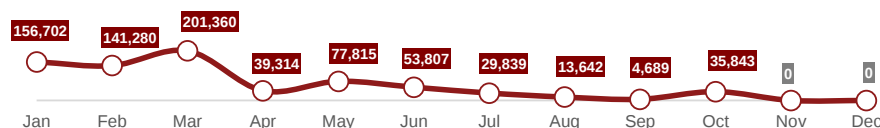
