

# Cameroon September 2024

#### **HIGHLIGHTS**

- Important floodings in the Far North regions and in Chad have caused additional displacements. 427,380 individuals will need adequate shelter and NFI by the end of the rainy season considering that already 56,084 houses have been destroyed by the water. The Shelter Working Group would have the capacity to assist 183,500 people in the Far North region with emergency shelter, NFI and houses rehabilitation for a total amount of 22 MUSD\$.
- The Shelter/NFI sector managed to secure a total of 2,320,000 USD\$ via CERF Underfunded Emergency and Rapid Response allocations that will be used for the assistance of approximately 46,600 people affected by the floods in Lagone et Charie and Mayo Danay.


#### **RESPONSE**

- A total of 103,517 people received NFI assistance and accessed adequate shelter through emergency – transitional – durable interventions.
- In the Far North region 8592 households have been assisted with shelter items/kits and household items while a total of 6039 households gained access to transitional/emergency shelters and 1170 got their house rehabilitated or reconstructed.
- In the North-West, South-West regions 6699
  households have been assisted with shelter items/kits
  and household items while 1303 households gained
  access to shelter through rental support.

#### **GAPS / CHALLENGES**

- Operational capacity drastically decreasing in the NW-SW regions (from 12 to 4 partners during last year)
- o Lack of a contingency stock
- Partners capacity in applying for funds and absorb them
- Lack of flexible, timely, multi-year, local and traceable funding
