
Action Point	Update
Cash for Shelter Training to be held in Bamenda and Buea	Cash Trainings were held and supplementary materials were shared with partners to continue your learning particularly on shelter markets and for adapting them to the programming.
Shelter Kit Checklist usage	Some planned distributions were postponed in November due to insecurity; focus of partners who have already done distributions should be to use the tool to follow up with how the kit has been used after distribution and to provide support to those households who have struggled to use it to improve their shelter conditions.
HLP AoR to share example of tenancy agreement so that partners can provide secure enough tenure	Present template shraed by HLP AoR
Use of PDM	Plan and UNHCR have used some components of the tool which helped in updating 5W – Do other agencies plan to use?
IMC to share updates on conditions in health centers where IDPs are taking shelters during security incidents	Shared



First Use of PDM tool

- Reconciliation of MPC on shelter uses: 207 HH(447) out of used MPC on shelter related expenses (less than half of targeted households)
- 73% of households were living below 3.5m2 per person
- Living Space: 44% stated they were satisfied, 37% said they were dissatisfied, 12% stated they were neither dissatisfied nor satisfied or preferred not to say, 3% stated they were very satisfied, and 3% stated they were very dissatisfied
- Privacy: 49% stated they were satisfied, 35% stated they were dissatisfied, 9% stated they were neither satisfied nor dissatisfied or preferred not to say, 5% stated they were very satisfied, and 2% stated they were very dissatisfied
- Ventilation: 67% of households were satisfied with the ventilation in their shelter, 20% were dissatisfied, 8% were satisfied, while 4% were neither satisfied nor dissatisfied or preferred not to say
- Safety: 30% stated that they felt that their shelter was unsafe while 70% stated that their shelter was safe.



HPC Process

- 9 projects
- \$ 13,779,993.00 requested
- Average: \$158.16 per beneficiary
- 294,460 people targeted (137,381 IDPs, 71,540 Returnees, 85,538 Non-displaced)

MSNA Data Collection Next Round

- Shelter Cluster Advocating for use of Settlement level Identifiers with IOM and OCHA
- Added ownership back to types of tenure
- Requested IOM to convert IDPs to number of estimated
 IDPs per shelter similar to the returnee category
- Requested IOM to collect how many IDPs live in all types of collective centres regardless of number of Idps,
- Requested to change market question to do they sell this item here? and requested to find out if market is weekly, daily, monthly, etc.
