
# **Gaza August 2022 Escalation**

**Dashboard**Report Date: 09 August 2022

All figures are initial and may change according to damage assessment

Between 5 and 8 August 2022, the Gaza Strip witnessed another escalation in which many buildings were destroyed or damaged and hundreds of people were internally displaced. According to the information verified by Shelter Cluster based on figures from MoPWH, MoSD, and other cluster partners at height of the conflict over 535 individuals fled their homes due to the intensive air strikes and the destruction of their houses, the air strikes on Gaza left 21 housing units totally destroyed and 77 housing units severely damaged and an estimated 1,793 housing units with different levels of damage. This dashboard summarizes the needs, responses and gaps in shelter related to this escalation.

### Urgent needs

Provision of NFIs and dignity kits to displaced people and who have partially damaged homes

#### Cash rent allowances for IDPs

Provision of transitional shelter cash assistance and reintegration package for eligible IDP families .

### Repair

77 HU with severe damage to reduce the IDPs caseload 1,793 HU with partial damage to maintain living conditions to minimum standards

### Medium and long term needs

Reconstruction of 21 HU that have been totally destroyed
