

Overview

The Southern part of Oromia Region, particularly the Borena Zone, is facing unprecedented drought, where many displacements have been reported in the past three months. Close to 400k IDPs are sheltered in new informal settlements in Dubuluk, Dire, Dhas, and Elawye woredas. Among these, 40% are living in spontaneous collective centers, and 60% are sheltered in the Host Communities in Dire, Yabello, Dhas, Dubluk, Elawye, Moyale, Dilo, Arero, and Wachile Woredas. IDPs are living in makeshift shelters constructed from whatever material they could salvage such as wooden sticks, old clothes, and pieces of plastic sheet which provides little protection from the wind and rain. According to the ETT 160/161, an additional 8,089 individuals/1798HHs were recently displaced in Teltele, Arero, Elawye, and Moyale woredas.

In the Somali region, IDPs who were displaced due to drought are still in displacement, and there is the possibility of more movement as many of the zones are in the dry season where water shortages have been reported, with southern zones being most severe i.e Liban, Afder, and Dawa. An Incident Command Post (ICP) has been established at Hargele town, which meets on a bi-weekly basis. Two cluster partners (SESEDA and CAAP) attend the ICP and have active projects supporting with ESNFIs in Barey, Hargele, and Godgod woredas.

Protection risks were also reported from IDPs in the Afder zone, linked to a lack of proper shelters. Women and girls at the sites are at risk of GBV. In Nogob zone, high measles cases were reported; recent protection monitoring reports indicated that makeshift congested shelters contributes to the transmission of the disease. The influx of Asylum seekers in Doolo zone has also put more pressure on the protracted drought IDPs and Host communities in that area.

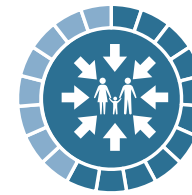

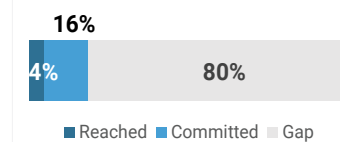

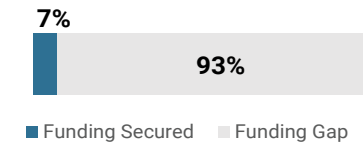


Drought Affected IDP Shelters : Borena Zone, Oromia region

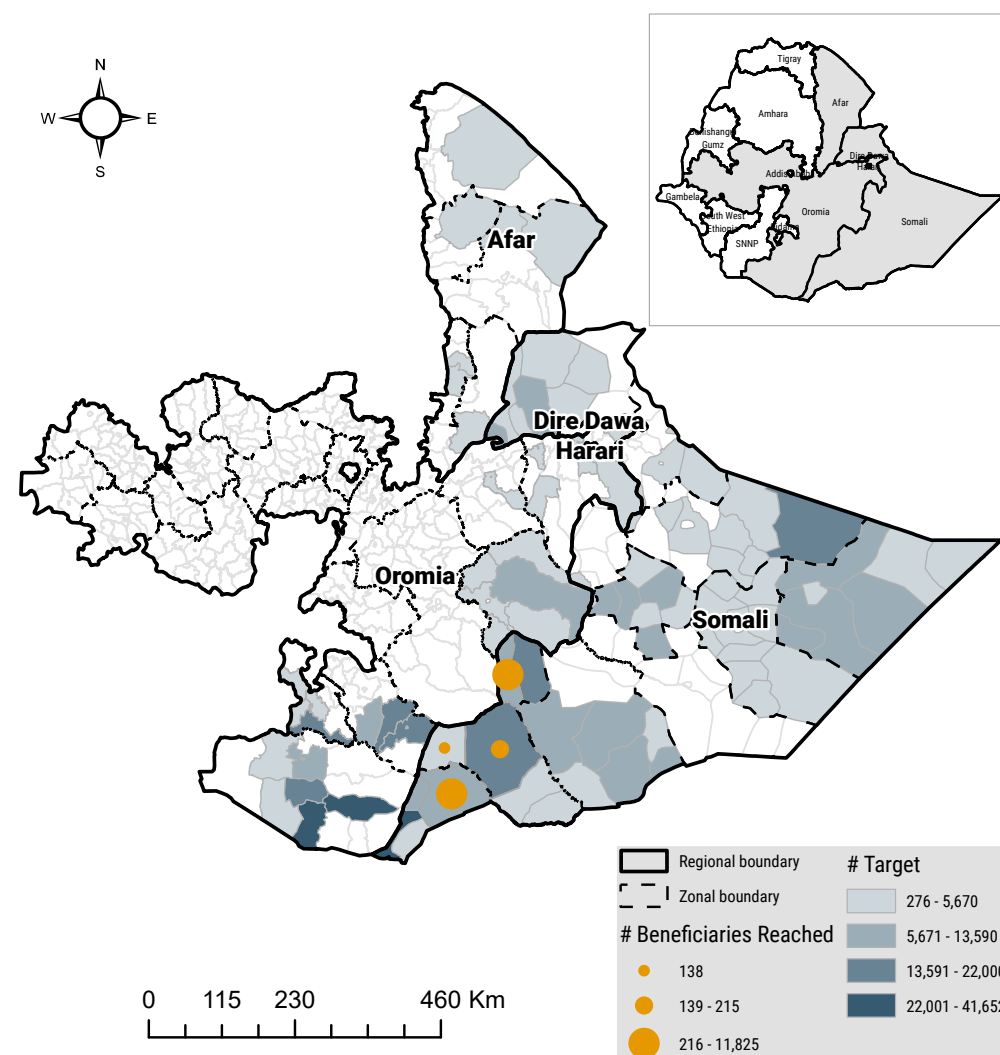

Funding Response-Gap Analysis

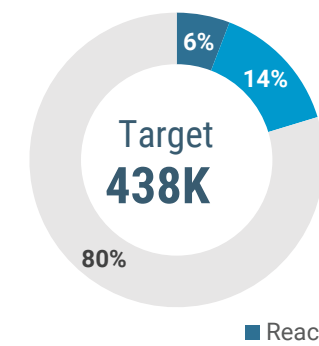


People Targeted And Reached By Woreda

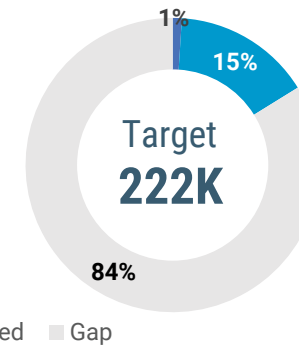


Response and Gap Analysis Per Activity

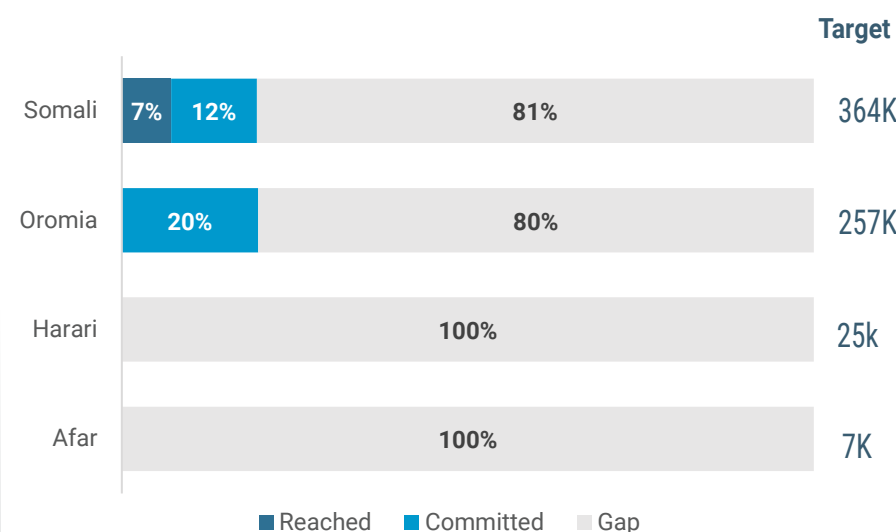

Emergency Shelter Assistance

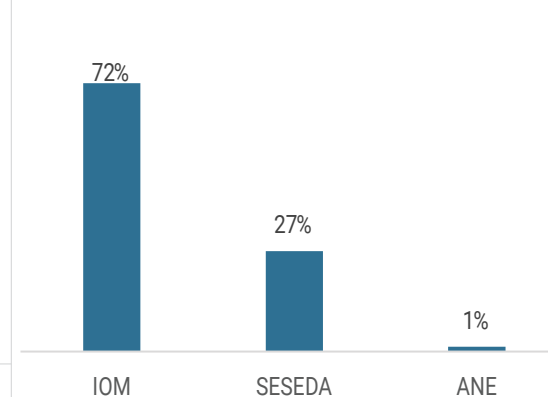


Response-Gap Analysis Per Region

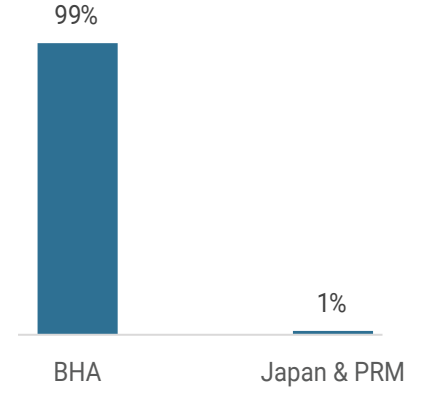

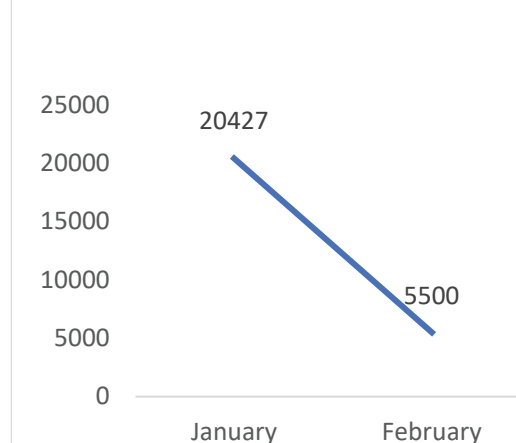

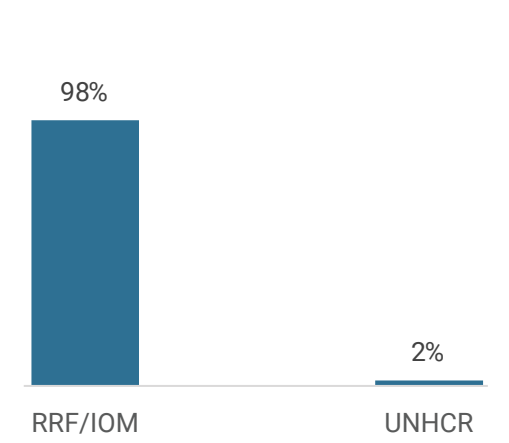
