WHO WE ARE

The Global Shelter Cluster (GSC) is an Inter-Agency Standing Committee (IASC) coordination mechanism that supports people affected by disasters and internally displaced people affected by conflict with the means to live in safe, dignified and appropriate shelter. The GSC enables better coordination among shelter actors, including local and national governments, so that people who need shelter assistance get help faster and receive the right kind of support.

The Global Shelter Cluster was established in 2005 and it is co-led by UNHCR (conflict IDP situations) and IFRC (natural disasters) at the global level. The Shelter Cluster is an inter- agency mechanism that coordinates shelter, settlement, and shelter-related non-food items (NFIs) during a humanitarian response for internal displacement (IDP) situations.

CLEAR-SPACE & SCALE

CLEAR SPACE

The minimum clear-space around the logo preserve its integrity and should be always maintained. The minimum clear-space is determined by the height of the text “Global Shelter Cluster” and should be applied on all four sides of the logo. To maintain visual clarity and provide maximum impact, the logo must never be crowded by copy, photographs or graphical elements or be placed too close to the edge of the page.



SCALE

For a reason of legibility, the logo should never appear smaller than the minimum size shown on this page. When the logo is used at his minimum size, it should appear without the baseline.

These colors are the colors of the logotype. They are considered as the primary color palette. Their use is predominant. GSC Red is the main color (titles, etc.).

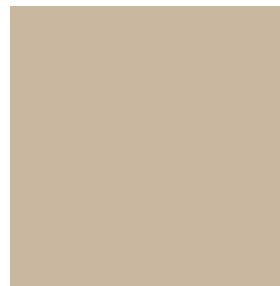
