

HIGHLIGHTS

- Strategy workshops have been held in Maroua (Far North region) and in Bamenda (North-West region) in February and April.
- In the NW Region the SNFI needs assessment implemented by PLAN has been presented and findings validated by partners. The same initiative will take place in the South-West end of April in Buea. Assessment data collected in the West region by DEDI will be presented in a second moment in Bafoussam.
- The 2022 Cameroon HNO/HRP have been launched and published on the 14th of April. A special conference was held in Yaounde with relevant Ministries.
- Following the Strategy workshop, the Cash WG led by WFP is looking at mainstreaming assistance modality over sectors. As SNFI and FSL are the sectors mostly using Cash/Voucher modality, coordinators in Yaounde will provide disaggregated data.

RESPONSE


- In first quarter of 2022, the Shelter/NFI response in the **North-West** and **South-West** regions assisted a total of 4,459 households of which 3,311 households with NFIs, 1,113 households with shelter kits and 35 households with rental assistance. Of this assistance 71% has been delivered through in-kind modality while 29% through voucher. The highest reach has been so far achieved in Mbonge and Fungon sub-divisons. Most of the operations implemented so far have been funded by ECHO.
- In the Far North region the Shelter/NFI response assisted a total of 14,902 households mainly with NFIs and shelter materials. The assistance has been delivered 100% through in-kind modality and the highest reach has been achieved so far in Mogode and Lagone et Birni.

- Coordination between national and sub-national forums
- Coherence of the response within/across regions
- o Predictability in planning activities over the year
