
## **General Background**

- Country crisis since 2015
   (Official regional response established in 2018)
- Socioeconomic & political crisis in Venezuela, current main problems:
  - lack of public services
  - levels of inflation
  - human rights violations

#### **Outside Venezuela**

- Venezuela refugees and migrants' influx:
  - 6.13M outside country of origin
  - **5.08M** in the region





#### What is R4V?

- Regional R4V Platform 

  Sectorial response co-led by UNHCR and IOM
  - Inspired by (but isn't): Cluster Structure under OCHA leadership or Refugee Response Coordination Model of UNHCR
- Includes participation of 259 implementing partners under the Regional Refugee and Migrant Response Plan (RMRP)









#### Where is the R4V activated?

- 17 different countries across the region, divided in 8 platforms
  - Brazil
  - Chile
  - Colombia
  - Ecuador
  - Peru
  - The Caribbean (Aruba, Curacao, the Dominican Republic, Guyana, Trinidad and Tobago)
  - Central America & Mexico (Panama, Costa Rica, Mexico)
  - Southern Cone (Argentina, Uruguay, Bolivia, Paraguay)










#### **Shelter Sector: Priorities**


- Temporary Collective Shelters □ (1) Management, (2) Improvement of physical infrastructure / equipment, and (3) Capacity building
- Individual Shelter Solutions ☐ (1) Rental Assistance, (2) Rooms at hotels/hostels, and (3) Access to adequate housing
- Settlement-based approaches ☐ (1) Community Engagement, and (2) Settlement Infrastructures and Services interventions
- Essential household items & Transit Safety kits distributions


