- ☐ 16 projects validated for a total caseload of 24,000 (!)

- ☐ **36.000 crossed the border to ask asylum to Chad. Other 35.000 have been displaced to villages in Diamaré, Logone et Chari and Mayo Sava**
- ☐ **35.102 IDPs, 4.844 HHs**
- ☐ **Majority are women and children**
- ☐ **98% are Arabes Choa, 100% muslims, 36% without a job, 32% employed in agriculture, 18% employed small in shops/markets**
- ☐ **77% of IDP are on informal sites, the rest stays at host family (9% renting)**
