The process

- ☐ ToR shared with SAG and approved;
- ☐ Advertisement done through OCHA;
- ☐ Sélection Committee identify the candidate;
- ☐ MoU between UN Lead and Co-Chair/s.



- ☐ UNHCR 120,000 USD\$ grant IDPs STEP UP Initiatve
- ☐ Selection process and criteria (PA via invitation, waiver applies)
 BASED on Experience level in Assessment in CMR, already present in country



Time frame

19 July: CN ready
by 22 July Invitations sent
by 29th of July deadline for submissions
by the 5 th of August Partner selection
On the 8th of August Implementation starts
August – September data collection 1st round
On October data cleaning/analysis 1st round
On December data collection 2 nd round; final cleaning and
analysis.
