


Shelter Cluster Snapshot - Gaza February 2022

Conflict Damages Figures/Responses




Internal displacement from Escalations of some 1800 families (10,000 individuals) will continue due to delay in funding and reconstruction


Transitional Shelter Cash Assistance (TSCA)
