




ESUPER EMERGENCY SUPPLY PRE-POSITIONING STRATEGY to reduce gaps and overlaps in emergency preparedness

Pillar 1 – STOCKHOLM – ITEM GROUP

ITEM GROUPS functionality

- Support a first phase of nomenclature standardisation
- Facilitate agreggation of data and extraction of reports (previous attempts like LogIK unsuccessfull)
- Does not prevent input of details or local names etc..
- Cannot be owned by « logistics » and should be kept up to date
- Needs to liaise with other initatives











ITEM GROUP SHELTER

| SHELTER (10) | - Shelter Tool Kit – Any kits containing a rope, a handsaw, a bag of nails for wood, a bag of nails for roofing, a shovel, a hoe, a pair of shears, a tie wire, a claw hammer, and a measuring tape |

| | - Sleeping mats - sleeping mats, traditional woven mats, etc |
| | - Other Tools and Hardware – Nails, Fencing inches, Crew bars, Safety Helmets, Knife, Pitch Fork, axe, fencing posts, barb wire, bush knives, gloves, claw hammer, Fencing brackets, mattocks, etc |
| | - Tents – family tents 16m2, Multipurpose tent, Coleman tent (Note that large Storage tent will fall under Logistics cluster) |
| | - Tarpaulins – tarps 6x4, tarps 5x3, with eyelet or not, plastic sheeting, |
| | - Solar lanterns - solar lamp, solar lanterns, LUCI Solar lamp, |
| | - Other lamps/ lanterns – Torch Battery, Kerosene lamp, Hurricane lanterns, Community lamps, |
| | - Kitchen set - Type A, Type B, any kits containing cutlery, plates, cooking pots, frying pan, bowls, cups for a family of 5 |
| | - Other Kitchen Items: items sitting by themselves such as forks, knives, Spoons, Plastic box, Enamel plates, Dishes, plastic cups, lunch box, |
| | - Blankets – High Thermal, medium thermal, locally procured, synthetic, fleece, woollen, linen single bedsheet, etc |
| | - Household kits and other Items: carpet, fans, table, etc |

- Blankets
- Cooking sets
- Plastic sheeting
- Jerry cans
- Mosquito nets (HEALTH)

Clothes: Saree, Teri, Jackets, Tee shirt, Malong, Shawl, etc..
