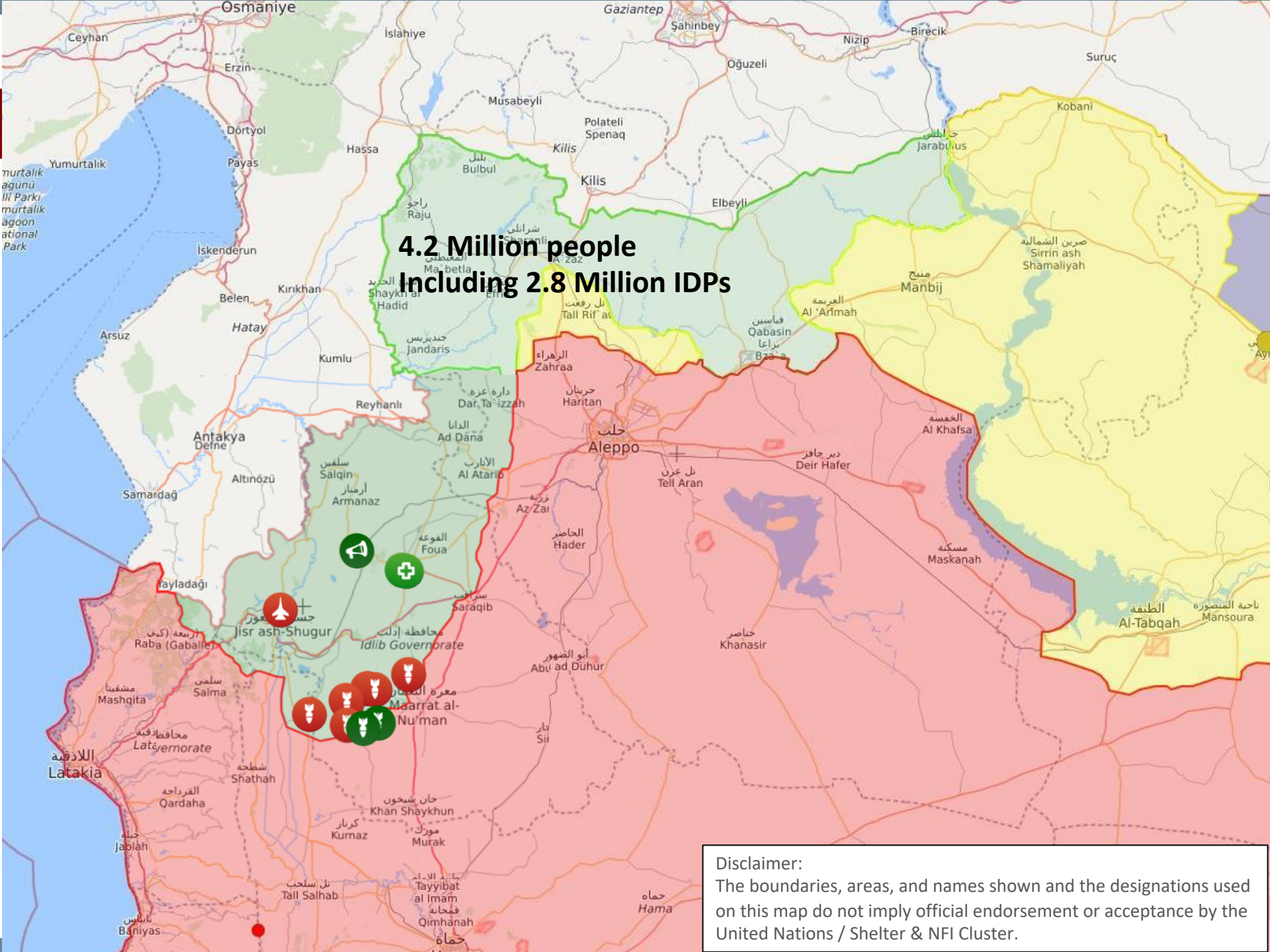

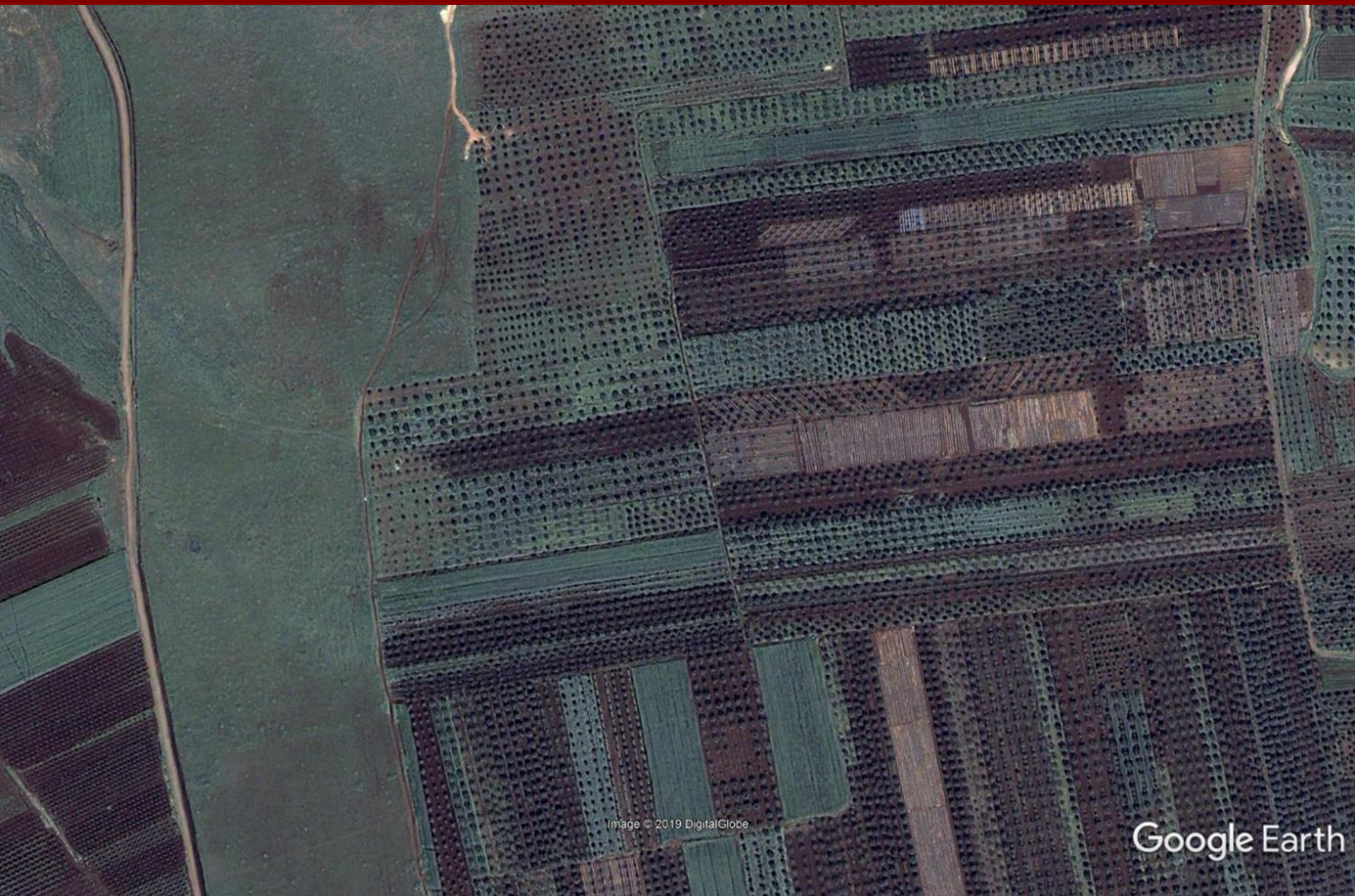

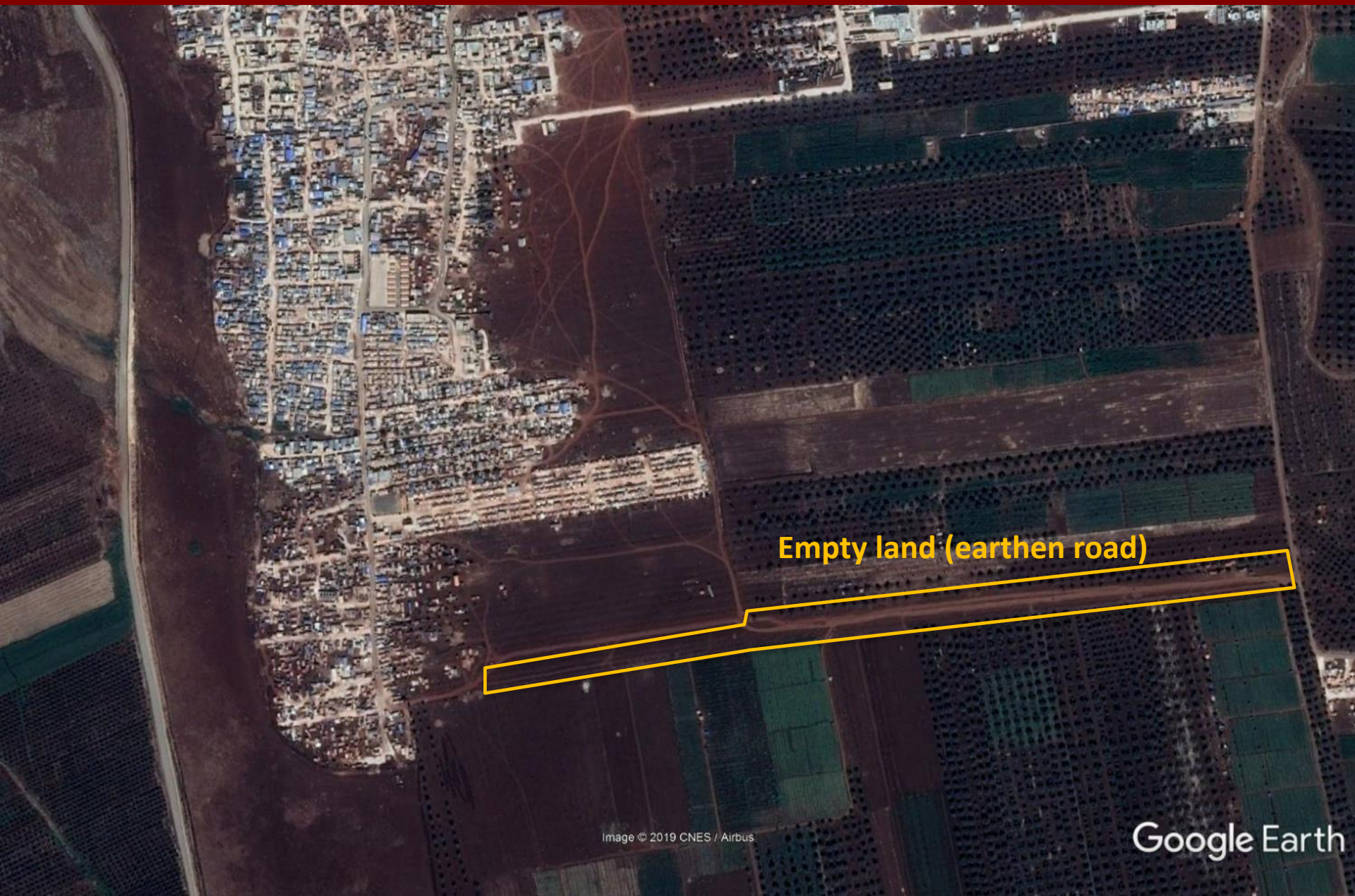

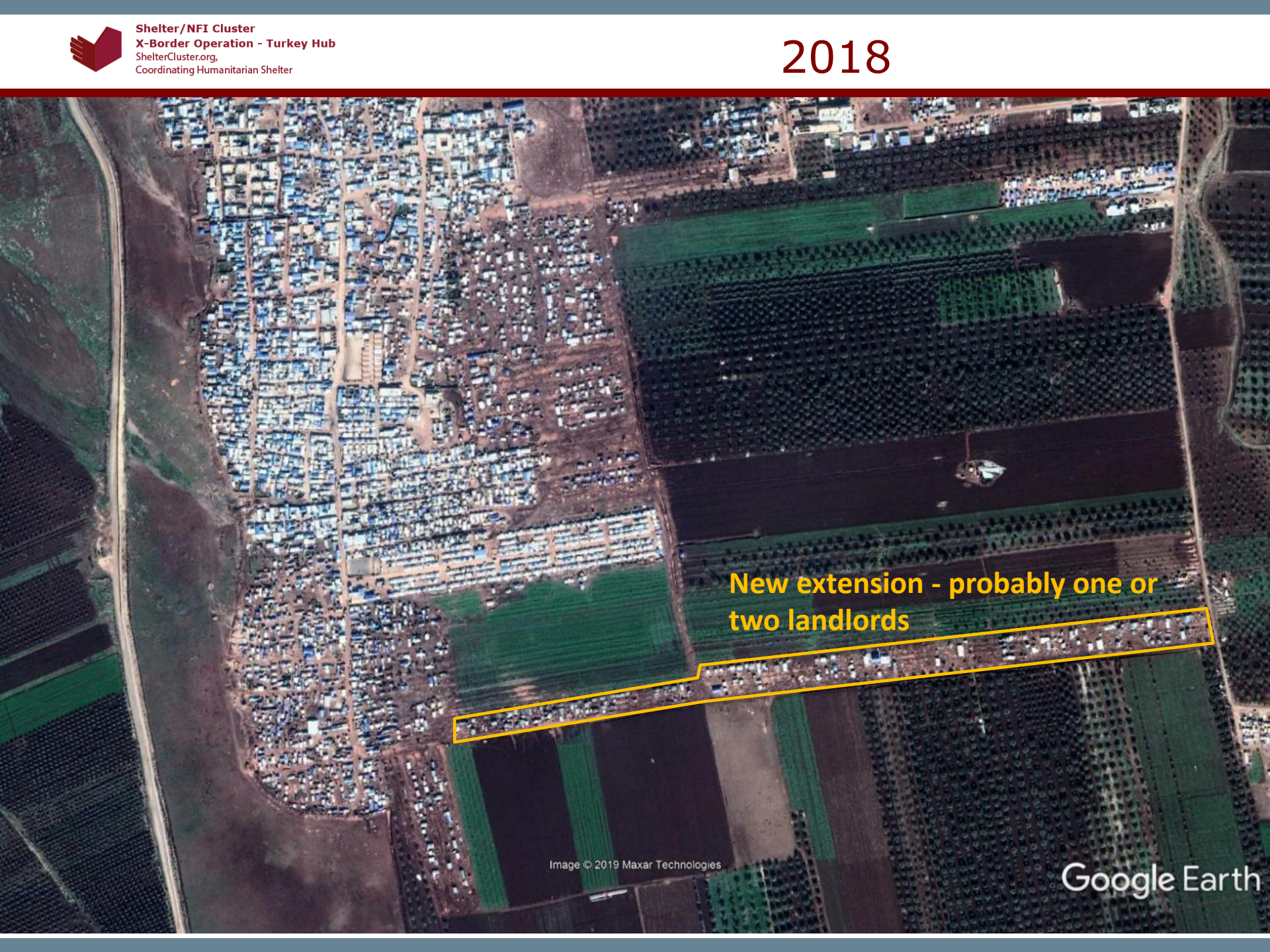

- poor WASH infrastructuresRisk of floods
- Risk of fire (No fire breaks, only 1 or 2 meters between tents)
- GBV risks (no lights, toilets not gender segregated...)

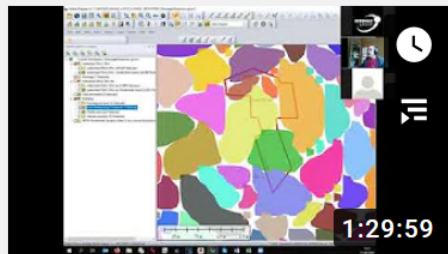

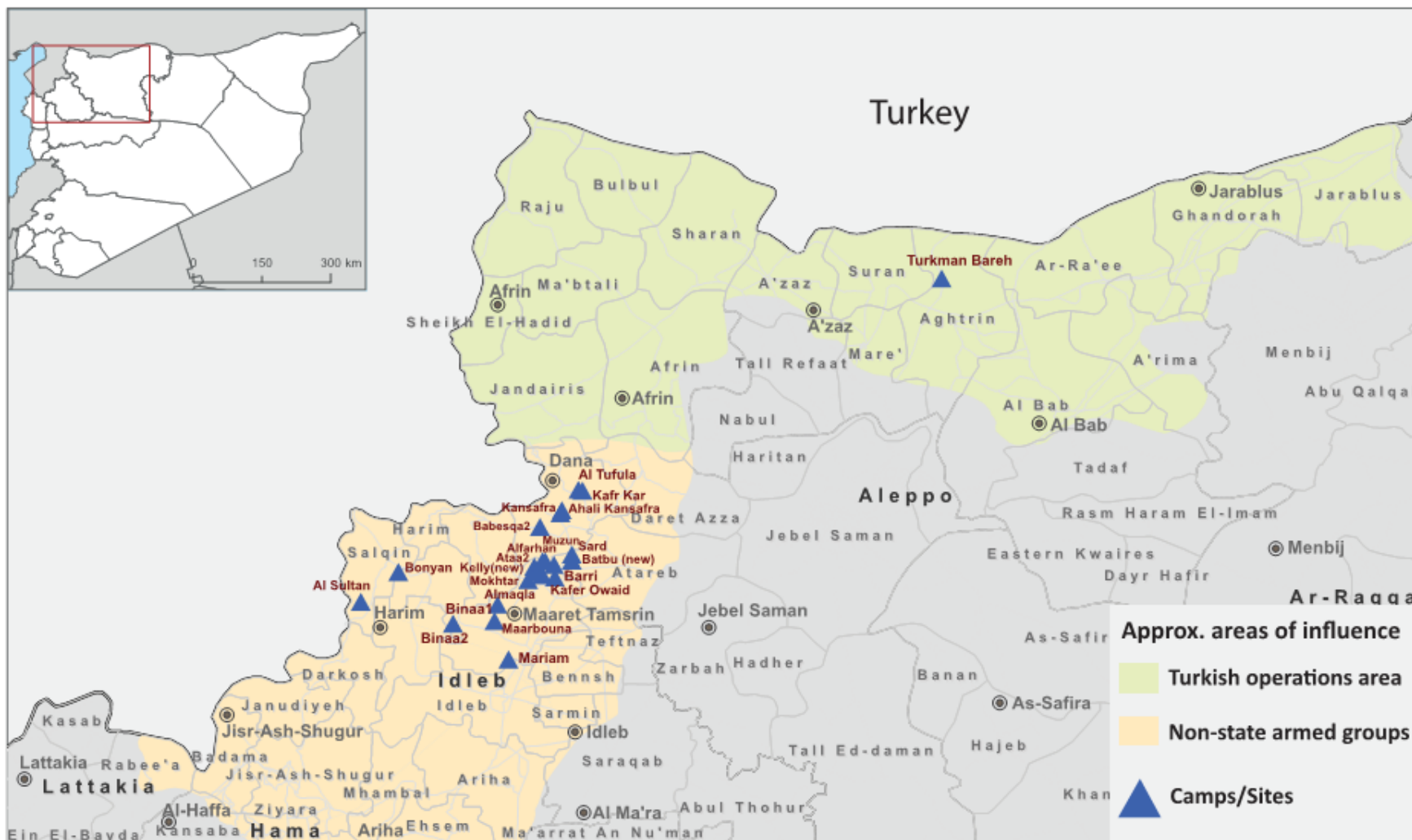
New strategy – Planned IDP settlements

- 27837 IDPs living in improved camps



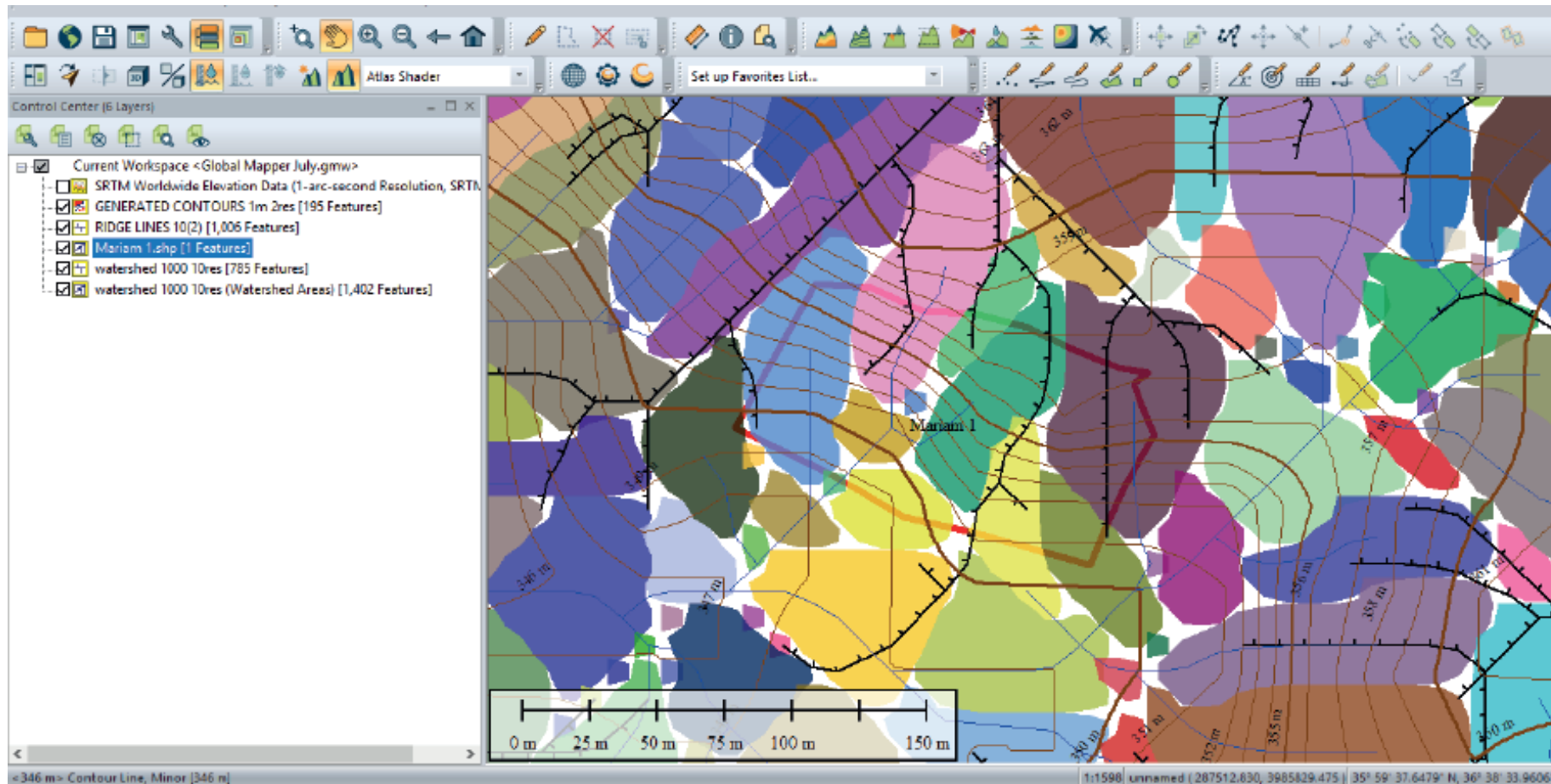
Geographical coverage

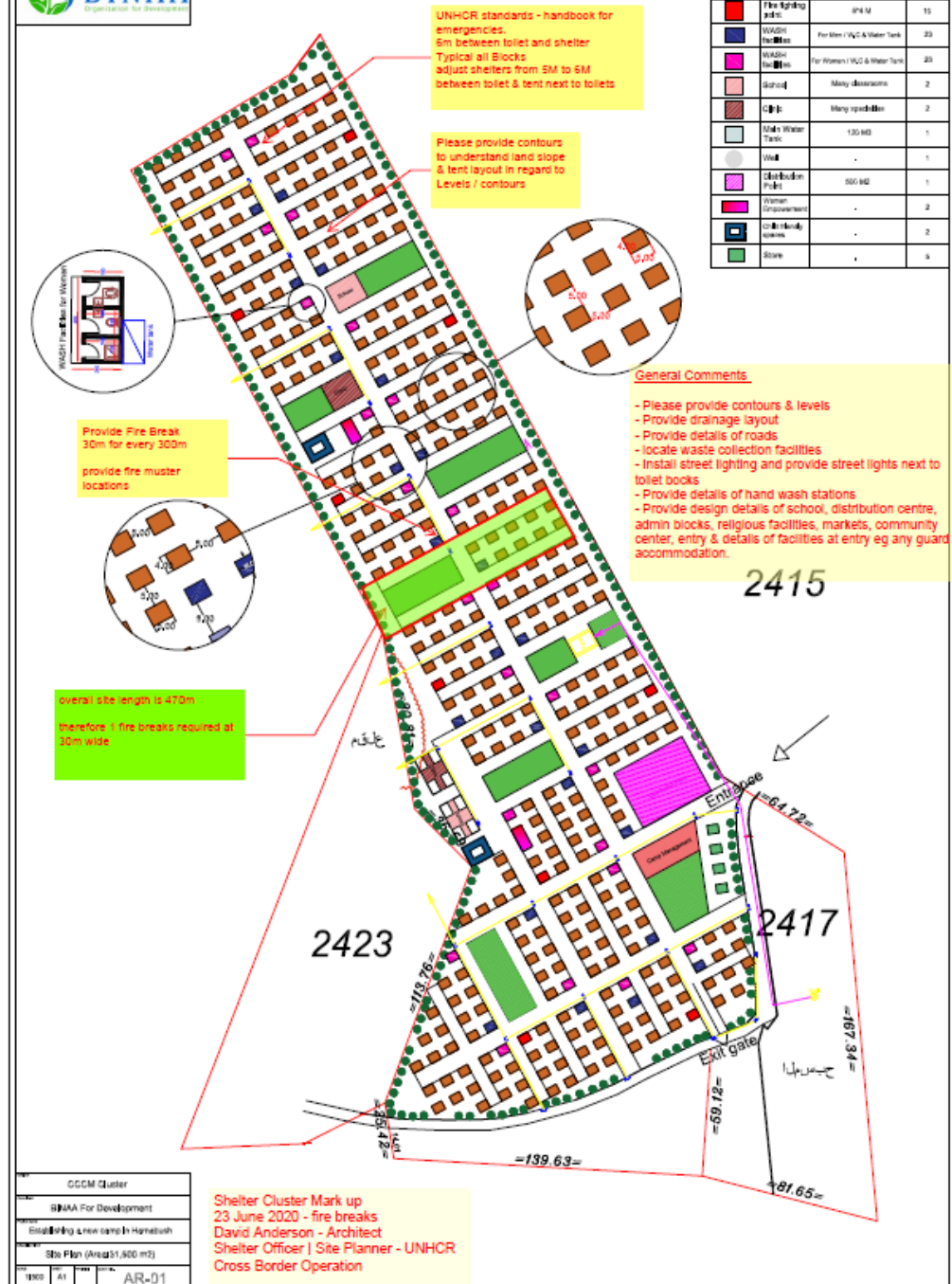

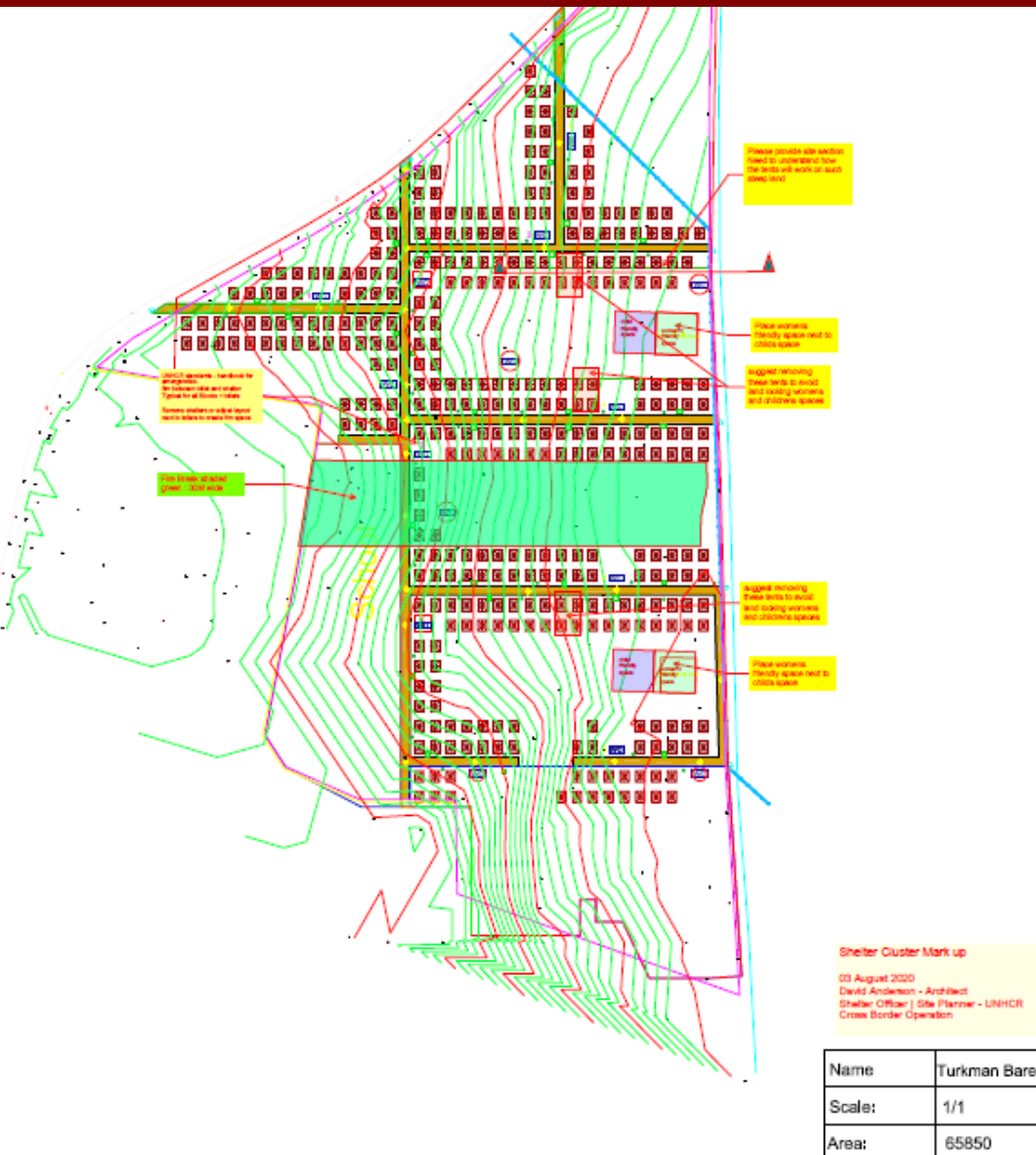

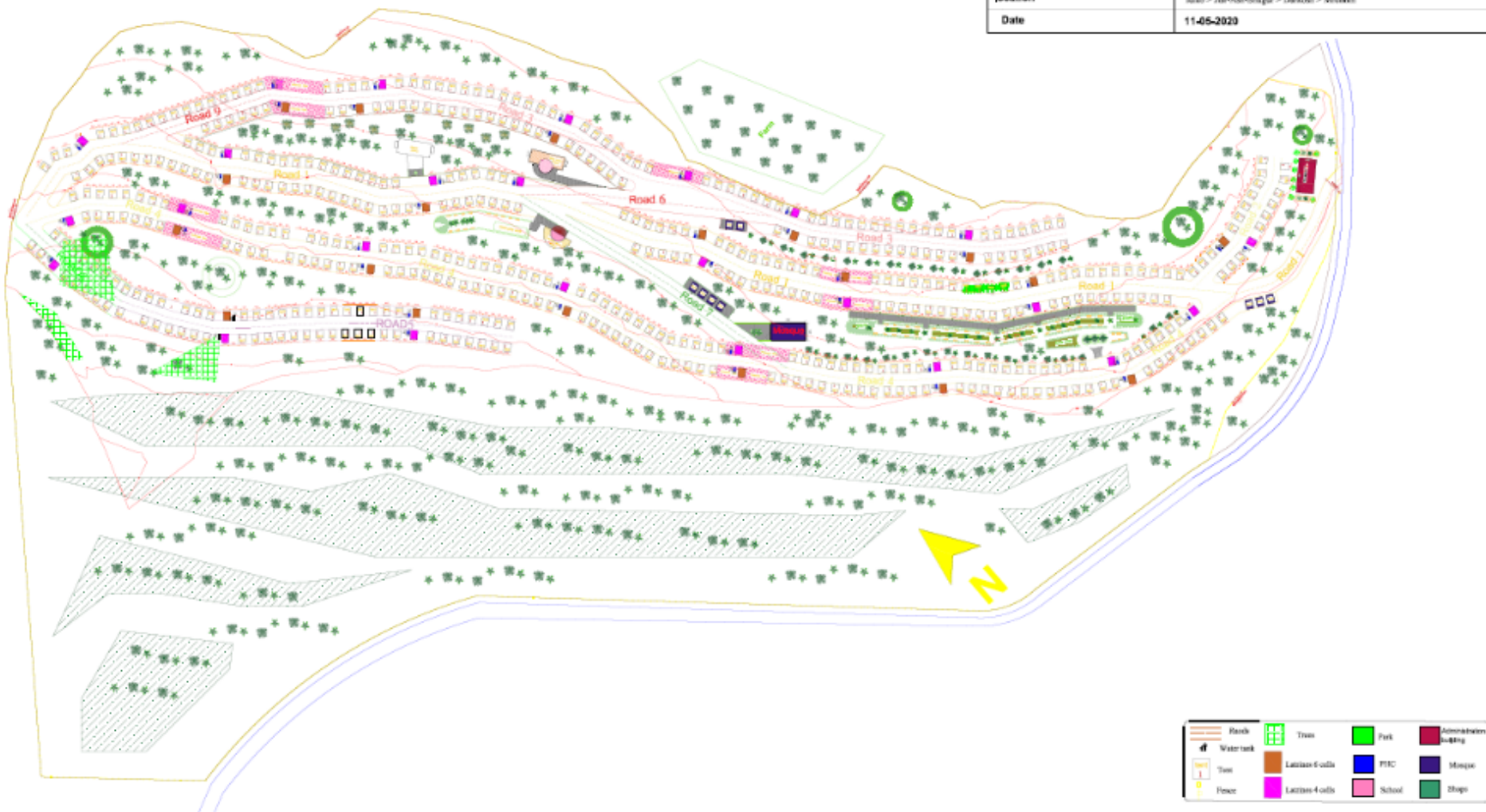
