

## **Current Situation**

- ARSOW Nepal has completed distribution of Blanket, mattress, rope, plastic sheet and nails to 477 HHs.
- Distribution of NRP 10,000 to 2932 HHs of 3 VDCs of Kavre by Nepal Red Cross Society is in progress. Similarly, CRED is distributing blanket, tarpaulin, bed foam and solar light to 917 HHs of Koshidekha VDC.
- Various agencies in Kavre have a confirmed plan to distribute only blankets (depending on the need) to 19,335 HHs which will be started by next week.

## **Background**

Almost 92% of all HHs have been damaged. Cash and CGI was distributed by agencies to 16,172 HHs in total, which is much less than the required total. To alleviate this gap, the government has distributed NPR 15,000 to all totally damaged HHs
