

SITUATION OVERVIEW AND NEED ANALYSIS


- 1.7 M people are living 1,400 unplanned sites and camps.
- 80% of people living in IDP sites in NWS are women and children. 38,000 people are reported to be living with specific needs.
- With **2.2 million** people in need of shelter assistance and more than **750,000** people living in tents and makeshift shelters, the severe winter months are a major humanitarian challenge in NWS.

PLANS AND LIMITED RESPONSE


- Planned partner response: 42M USD.
- Secured funds: 22M USD.
- Total individuals targeted through secured funds: 870,236
- Only 52% of funding has been received to meet basic winter needs.
- Urgent need for a timely response.
