Introduction

This is the Whole of Syria (WoS) Shelter and NFI Sector (SNFI) analysis of the Syria Multi-Sector Needs Assessment (MSNA) 2021. The analysis feeds into the 2022 Syria Humanitarian Needs Overview (HNO) and into the sector's 2022 response planning. The analysis is intended for humanitarian planning only.

The dashboard is made in a way to be used interactively. By clicking on a filter or specific point on a map will return the data for the specific selection. Similarly, by clicking on any table of content header, will direct you immediately to the selected chapter.

MSNA 2021 methodology

- 1. The MSNA is a household assessment that shows needs across Syria and sectors and helps inform evidence-based decision-making.
- 2. Data was collected from 10th August to 20th September 2021.
- 3. A total of 33.171 households were assessed.
- 4. A total of 267 of 270 sub-districts were covered. Sub-districts not covered were Kafr Zeita (Hama governorate), Rabee'a (Lattakia governorate) and Heish (Idleb governorate).
- 5. The data is representative on sub-district level for total population and on district level for population groups (confidence level is 95% nd margin of error is 10%).
- 6. With the exception of the income (in SYP) analysis, all figures are weighted. Weights are based on population group and population density.

Limitations and biases

- 1. Almost all households surveyed live in finished undamaged or slightly damaged apartments or houses.
- 2. Representative levels on population groups are limited depending on number of responses to certain questions. Particularly for *returnees* findings should be rather interpreted as trends.
- 3. Seasonal fluctuation: The MSNA 2021 was conducted in later summer, thus, crucial needs such as winterization might not have been reported as a top priority by households.
- 4. Access issues predominantly occurred in Idleb when accessing camps.








Top 3 humanitarian needs, by respondents*






Shelter priority (# of sub-districts)








Year of displacement, % of IDP respondents






Satisfaction with received assistance







HHs received assistance in the past 3 months

Key finding

While 25% of households in the MSNA 2020 responded that they were not satisfied with the assistance received, the figure more than doubled in the MSNA 2021, with 56% if households reporting not to be satisfied with the assistance.





Inhabited shelter type by share of population




Key finding

According to the MSNA 2021, less households are living in damaged apartments/buildings (20%) compared to the MSNA 2020 (28%). However, households reportedly living in last resort sites more than doubled from about 3% (MSNA 2020) to abut 7% (MSNA 2021).










Occupancy arrangement 2021
















Adequacy issues, % of respondents reporting adequacy issues*










HHs' ability to meet basic needs (compared to 2020)




HHs' ability to meet basic needs, by governorate



Expenditure distribution 2021 (SYP)









Agriculture and productive assets, clothing (only 2021), debt payment, disability related costs (only 2021), education services, electricity, food, health care, hygiene items (only 2021), NFI, fuel (only 2021), other payments, phone/data/communication, rent, safe water, shelter maintenance, and transportation.










NFI severity changes between HNO 2022 and HNO 2021, by # of sub-district






